## No damage estimates yet

# Missing chemicals found

SHELL BEACH La. — Divers searching the murky water of the Mississippi River Gulf Outlet Wednesday found a container that held 25,000 pounds of a deadly chemical, missing since a ship collision last week. The container was "extensively damaged" and some of the bags were ripped open.

Coast Guard spokesmen said preparations to recover the poison would begin immediately. A heavy derrick barge was moved into position near the 20-foot metal cargo container to begin lifting it out of the ship channel.

When the container fell off the M.V. Testbank in a collision with the bulk carrier M.V. Sea Daniel July 22, it was filled with about 720 50-pound sacks of pentachlorophenol, or PCP. About 220 bags were recovered, leaving an estimated 500 missing.

Gov. Dave Treen, who flew to the Coast Guard command post at New Orleans' Lakefront Airport for a briefing on the disaster, said the trouble was far from over.

"We have continuing problems, the magnitude of which is not clear," Treen said. Asked if he thought the spill would devastate the area's rich shrimp, fishing, and oyster harvests, Treen replied it was too early to tell.

"Our scientists are going to have to assess that," he said. "I guess we'll know more after we identify how much of this material we have and after it's been

retrieved. Of course, we will continue the test of the fish, oysters and the water."

Coast Guard coordinator Richard J. Clements said a diver was sent down before 2 p.m. when the container was located.

"He swam down to the bottom and could see the bags," Clements said. He said it was on the right side of the channel "the bottom there is sticky rather than silty."

Clements said the anchor of the Sea Daniel, bent, apparently by the PCP container.

"We can surmise that the container came off Testbank, got hooked by the anchor, and the ship Sea Daniel moved on it, was carried along or 400 feet," Clements said. "That's why it was up there than the other two containers."

Two containers of household goods and supplies were recovered earlier in the search. The released poisonous fumes of hydrotremic and another damaged container on the Testbank divers' search for the PCP container did not begin Saturday, four days after the accident.

Traces of PCP were found in the water. Authorities halted all fishing and shrimping seafood-rich area, bringing cries of outrage to Bernard Parish fishermen.

Special sonar scanners, magnetometers, and other devices were used in the search.
