**Sander, Runge named new dept. heads**

COLLEGE STATION — Dr. H. O. Kunkel, dean of the College of Agriculture at Texas A&M University, has announced the appointments of Dr. Eugene C. Sander as professor and head of the Department of Biochemistry and Biophysics, and Dr. Edward C. A. Runge as professor and head of the Department of Soil and Crop Sciences.

Sander comes to Texas A&M from the University of West Virginia where he was chairman of the Department of Biochemistry, School of Medicine. Kunkel said Sander is recognized as an enthusiastic, hardworking and accomplished teacher. He has authored more than 40 professional papers.

Sander received a master's degree and a doctorate in biochemistry from Cornell University. He earned a bachelor's of science degree from the University of Minnesota.

Runge comes to Texas A&M from the University of Missouri at Columbia, where he was professor and chairman of the Department of Agronomy.

Runge is noted for research on chemical systems important in soil development and on soil-plant-climate interactions. He is a fellow of the American Society of Agronomy and the Soil Science Society of America. Runge has authored or co-authored more than 60 scientific papers.

He received a doctoral degree in agronomy (soils) from Iowa State University where he minored in chemistry and statistics. He holds a master's of science in agronomy with a minor in chemistry and agriculture economics from the University of Illinois where he obtained a bachelor's of science with honors in agriculture education.

Both appointments were made jointly with the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station.

**IFT honors Carpenter**

Dr. Zerle L. Carpenter, head of the Department of Animal Science at Texas A&M University, has been elected a Fellow of the Institute of Food Technologists.

The honor was bestowed at the annual IFT meeting in New Orleans, La., in recognition of Carpenter's service to the industry, particularly in search work in meats and biology.

Carpenter has also been the editorial board of the Journal of Food Science and president of the Texas and the IFT. He is also president of the American Meat Science Association.

Carpenter has headed the department of Animal Science since last September when he was acting head for two years. He joined the staff at Texas A&M in 1964.

Much of his research teaching has focused on tenderness and beef palatability and distribution. He has done considerable work on lamb quality and carcass characteristics.

Other past honors and include the 1970 Faculty Teaching Achievement Award from the Texas Association of Formerly of the 1972 Meat Science Award from the American Society of Animal Science, Outstanding Educator Award from the National Association of Meat Purveyors, and the Distinguished Service Award from Gamma Sigma Delta.

**Begin won't accept talk conditions**

JERUSALEM — Prime Minister Menachem Begin made clear to Egyptian President Anwar Sadat in a letter drafted Tuesday that Israel will accept no preconditions for resuming the stalled Palestinian autonomy talks, aides said.

Begin's response was "almost completed" and aides said it was expected to be delivered today by Israeli Ambassador-to-Egypt Eliahu Ben-Ellisar.

Sadat delayed a new round of autonomy talks, scheduled for this week in Alexandria, because of the Knesset's passage of a bill declaring Jerusalem Israel's united capital.

The Egyptian leader reportedly sought a commitment from Israel to include discussion of the sovereignty of the autonomy districts despite the bill's passage.

"We are ready to negotiate an autonomy plan on the basis of Camp David accords and a treaty," the aides said. A document mentions Jerusalem.

"We do not accept preconditions suddenly that legitimizing the coming down of the talks," said a foreign ministry spokesman.

Israel "did not stop the negotiations and we should not have their renewal." It is an AN

"Jerusalem is not part of negotiations."

Begin's letter reportedly outlined obstacles Egypt has in the way of the peace talks, including the negotiations three years ago. He held his position on the autonomy talks, and said he described the obstacles in the way of the talks.
