

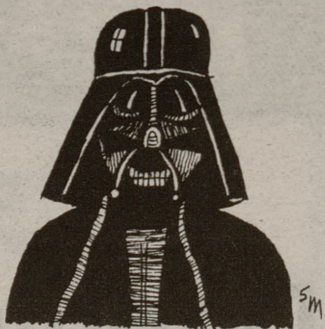
Film:

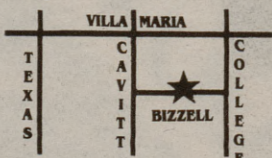
