Actor trained like athlete for 'Shogun'

Every role is a challenge to an actor, but few will probably match the physical and emotional demands of playing Blackthorne, the shipwrecked English navigator who becomes a samurai warrior in James Clavell's "Shogun," NBC's 12-hour mini-series about 17th-century Japan, to

be broadcast over five consecutive nights starting Monday, Sept. 15.

Richard Chamberlain, who appeared in virtually every scene during the six months of location filming in Japan, had to prepare for the role with an athlete's discipline.

"Before I even got the part

I knew they wanted somebody bigger than I am, so I started going to a gym for several months before coming out for meetings with James Clavell. I put on a lot of weight — about 12 pounds of muscle — and I really felt great.

"Unfortunately, I lost most of it during filming, but I

worked hard to keep up my stamina. I knew I had to be in good shape because it was a very physical role."

One advantage was the fact that Chamberlain enjoyed Japanese food — mostly fish, rice and vegetables.

"It's tremendously nourishing. I tried to eat well, sleep as much as I could, go running and get a lot of exercise. I had sort of a little gym with barbells set up in my room."

Japan's summer heat was a major problem during the filming, Chamberlain says. "The heat was relentless, especially when we were doing the boat scenes in Nagashima. I found I had to just sit very still in a chair, or hold an umbrella over me so the sun wouldn't scald me. It was the only way to conserve energy.

Total concentration was a key to his performance.

"It was a great test because with all the technical problems of the armies running in and out there was so little time for rehearsal. Hours were spent on lighting and staging all the extras.

"And then there was the language problem," he adds, referring to the fact that he was the only American in the cast. "There were so many endless translations, by the

time they got around to the actors you were expected to be right on the mark.

"It became like a game, which I found fascinating. It was like somebody was putting hurdles in your way, moment to moment, day after day, to see if you could deliver in front of the camera."

Japanese glossary

Most Japanese verbs end in *masu*. To make a question, just add *ka*. "Wakarimasu ka" means "Do you understand?" "Wakarimasu" means "I understand." To make the verb negative, change *masu* to *masen*. "Wakarimasen" is "I do not understand." Following is a brief glossary of Japanese terms that viewers will frequently hear while watching "Shogun":

Arigato (ari-gat-o) — Thank you

Domo (doe-mo) — Thank you or please

Dooshita Noda (doe-sta-noda) — What's the matter?

Dozo (doe-zo) — Please

Hai (hi) — Yes

Honto (hon-to) — Truth

Iye (e-yeh) — No

Ima (e-ma) — Now, at once

Isogi (e-so-gi) — Hurry

Koi (coy) — Come (command)

Konbanwa (con-ban-wa) — Good evening

Konnichiwa (con-nichi-wa) — Good day

Kudasai (ku-da-si) — Please

Matte (matt-te) — Wait

Sama (sam-a) — Lord

San (san) — Honorable (added to names as politeness)
