Former SWC official dies in California

IRVING — Howard Grubbs, executive secretary of the Southwest Conference for 23 years and a man who helped bring many of the changes in modern college football, has died at the age of 72.

Grubbs, who was also secretary-treasurer of the Cotton Bowl Athletic Association during his term as conference head, died Wednesday night at his home after a heart attack.

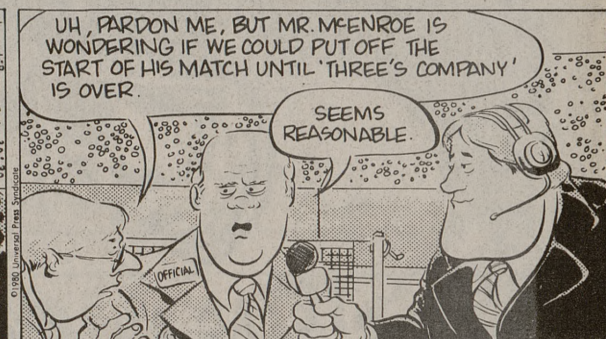
A native of Oakland, Calif., Grubbs was long associated with Texas Christian University as a student athlete and coach. He was quarterback of TCU's first Southwest Conference championship football team in 1929.

Later, after coaching at Lufkin High School from 1931-33, he was athletic director and assistant football coach at TCU from 1934-50. During his term at athletic director, TCU made the first of 12 bowl appearances.

Grubbs was a member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Executive Committee from 1950-54, a member of the Television Committee from its beginning until 1966. He was president of the Collegiate Commissioners Association from 1956-66 and a member of that group through out his career in the SWC.

In 1967, Grubbs was named to the Texas Sports Hall of Fame, for both his work as an administrator and his record as an athlete.

Softball — next year is here

When it comes to watching good softball, they say pitching is the key to the game.

"They" have obviously watched Texas A&M University's dynamic duo, Shan McDonald and Lori Stoll, to their stuff.

The two ace pitchers on the women's softball team led the Aggies to a third place finish in last year's national tournament in Norman, Okla.

In a heartbreaking series of games, the Aggies came within a few runs of making the national championship but has thus far eluded them. Every one of the seven games the Ags played was decided by one run, and unfortunately for McDonald and Stoll, the Aggies lost two games by 1-0 scores, the last loss coming at the hands of eventual champions Utah State in the loser's bracket finals.

This season, the women's team remains mostly intact, with one real difference — they want the national title.

Wednesday night, they answered

a few questions by sweeping the Baylor Bears, 12-0 and 4-0.

McDonald threw a no-hitter at the Bears in the first game, while Stoll could only manage a two-hitter in the second.

"I think we're looking good now," said Coach Bill Galloway Thursday. "Baylor isn't quite as good as they were last year."

If Texas A&M was a fine offensive team last year, Galloway said this year they're better.

"I would say we're a better hitting team than last year," he said.

Today the Aggies roll into San Antonio for the start of the San Antonio Invitational Tournament, and they will have a chance to play some stiffer competition than the Bears presented.

At 10 a.m., the team plays Incarnate Word Academy from San Antonio, and tonight at 7 p.m., the Aggies

take on tough Sam Houston State in what should be a good test of the Aggies' potential.

McDonald, who won 28 games last season, and Stoll, who captured 35, will take the mound for Texas A&M in alternating starts.

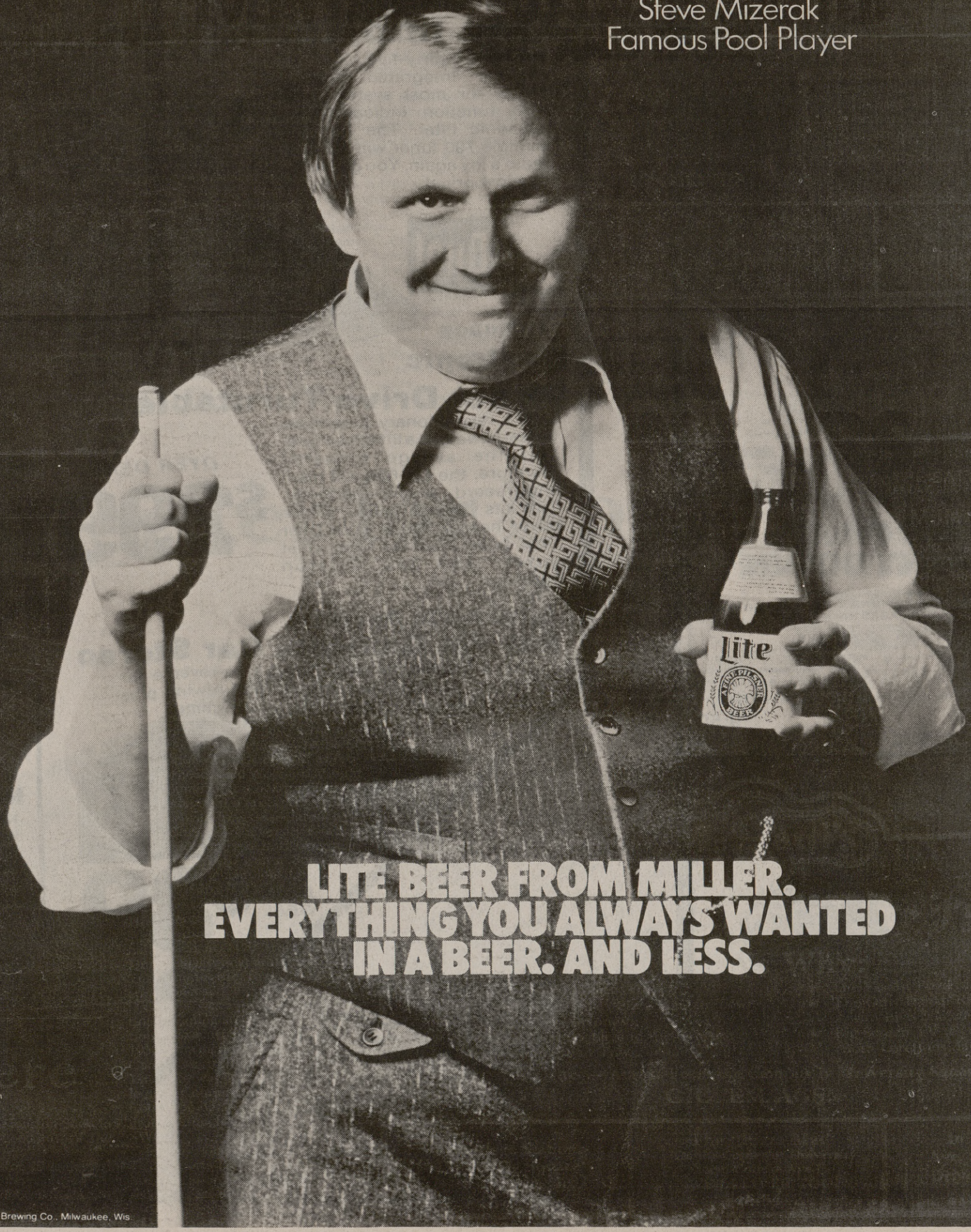
