Student Senate confirms appointments Wednesday

The Texas A&M University student senate confirmed the internal affairs committee appointments at the first senate meeting Wednesday. The committee consists of 12 senators, two of which are recommended by each of the five vice presidents and two by the speaker. The recommendations required a two-thirds vote of approval by the senate. The appointees are: Marilyn Hardy, Jeff Bissey, Rhonda Rhea, Adren Pilger, Bill Smith, Greg Hood, Matt

Reue, Bruce Walker, Steve Crumley, Lynda Beard, Luis Martinez and Phil Hannah. Speaker Ken Johnson will serve as chairman and Speaker Pro Tempore Jeff Anthony will be co-chairman. The committee's duties include interviewing candidates for senate vacancies, taking action on all articles of impeachment and any other internal affairs business brought before the committee. It may remove, suspend or censure a member of student government.

The committee also requests grade point ratio statements from all senators, vice presidents and the student body president at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. When a vacancy occurs the speaker announces the opening at a senate meeting, and applications are taken for one week after the announcement. Applicants are interviewed by the committee, which then makes its recommendations to the senate.

Burleson County Fair opens today

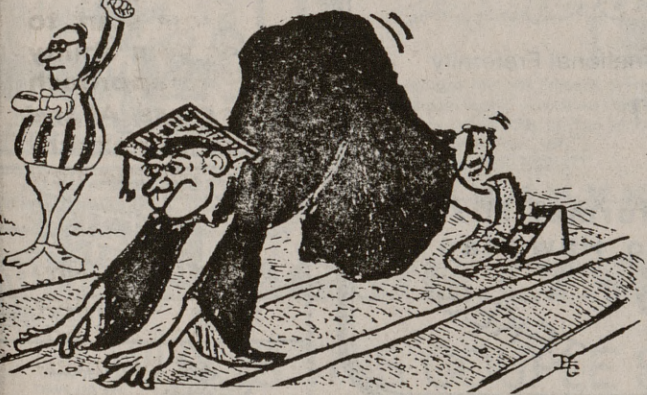

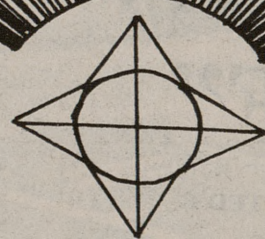
