## Benatar's new wave not old hat

Pat Benatar's debut effort, "In the Heat of the Night," brought forth a new talent to the rock world. Pat's opera training and vocal talents made of fans realize that there were other kinds of music lurking about.

Her follow-up "Crimes of Passion," is in the same vein. Benatar sticks to the formula that sent "In

the Heat of the Night" into the Gold territory. But that doesn't mean that this new one is monotonous or simply a re-hash.

"Crimes of Passion" opens with "Treat Me Right," a typical New Wave style rocker. Pat seems a little pre-occupied with the idea of the end of a romantic fling. The guitar interlude sounds a bit tired also.

"You Better Run" sports a choppy, Alice Cooperish rhythm track. On this cut, Pat tries too hard to sound angry. It doesn't become her.

The next two songs are more of what Benatar needs to strive for.

"Never Wanna Leave You" features singing in an airy, breathy voice not unlike old Diana Ross. The spare instrumental backing on "Never Wanna Leave You" makes this cut one of the best on the album.

"Hit Me With Your Best Shot" has definite sixties overtones. The rhythm guitar borrows heavily from the Kinks. And at least there is a hint of a smile to be found.

Side one closes with a clinker. "Hell is for Children" is a song about child abuse. While technically good, this song is definitely an over-reacher, bordering on the silly. Rock music is not known for serious inputs toward the solutions of social problems and this tune does nothing to change that. Benatar is a little heavy handed in her vocal effort here. Perhaps the song would work better if Gene Simmons sang it.

On side two Benatar slides back into more familiar territory. "Little Paradise" has a Bo Diddley syncopation to it that gives the song an upbeat feel. While the song is really nothing new, it avoids the dirge-like quality that ended side one.

"I'm Gonna Follow You" has Benatar in the same voice as "Never Wanna Leave You." I feel that this is Benatar at her best. The backing vocals are well arranged and fresh. Nick Gerardo's guitar work is solid throughout, but he shows his most original leads on "I'm Gonna Follow You."

Benatar's opera training is evident on "Wuthering Heights," a rock rendition of the Bronte classic.
