## Settlement offer bugs VW owner

**EAST HAVEN, Conn.** — Eileen Waldron has the kind of Volkswagen Beetle that's so pampered if it were a child it might be spoiled.  
She bought it new in 1965 and grew attached to the car she drove 220,000 miles. When the engine wore out, she got another one for the car and paid for it with a loan and put 30,000 more miles on the car.  
In 1977, a truck struck her Volkswagen's rear end. The Travelers Insurance Co. said their man was at fault.  
All Waldron wanted was to get "the car fixed the way it was before was hit." That would cost \$2,000.  
Nothing doing, said the Travelers' appraiser. We will buy the car from you outright for \$300.  
Bug off, she told them.  
She paid the repair cost with a loan and \$650 her insurance company provided on her collision coverage.  
The Travelers' appraiser based the car's worth on what he found in the "Blue Book," a manual prepared by the National Automobile Dealers Association, fixing the retail, wholesale and loan values of the car.  
It stated the car was worth \$100 — and he said he was being generous with his \$300 offer.  
"I intend to challenge this 'book value' scheme," Waldron said.  
She has taken Travelers to court, demanding \$100,000 in damages to "prove you have a right to have your car repaired, no matter what the cost, when it is wrecked through someone else's negligence."  
A December trial date is scheduled.  
Travelers, she said, finally sent her a check for \$425 as "full settlement."  
She refused to cash it.

## Doctors: Apathy keeps TB active

**BOSTON** — Doctors know enough about tuberculosis to make it as rare as some other diseases that once plagued humanity. But apathy about TB treatment and the spread of the disease threatens to keep it with us "well into the next century," Despite a decline in mortality from TB during the last 20 years, about 30,000 new cases are reported in the United States each year, particularly in urban areas — many cases are introduced overseas.  
Health officials, concerned to control TB were faltering, convened a symposium last year in Boston to develop strategies for the disease. Their recommendations were released Wednesday in the New England Journal of Medicine.  
"TB is still with us, and it is well into the next century," said symposium chairman Thomas E. Keam. "We have to be on guard, it so it won't increase again. We need to be watchful for symptoms."  
Nationally, the TB rate has fallen from 36.5 per 100,000 people in 1958 to 13.9 per 100,000 in 1977, Keam said, and the death rate has fallen from 7.1 per 100,000 in 1958 to 1.1 per 100,000 in 1977. However, Keam — co-author of the summary report with Peter Russo — cautioned that lax attention toward TB could cause it to re-emerge.  
"There's a general apathy re: TB because it has moved from the long-term sanitarium care to general practice," Keam said. "A \$100 of people feel the disease is gone, but it isn't. There's a lot of new cases coming into the United States from other countries."  
A skin test for TB is available would show whether a person is infected by the tuberculosis bacteria, Keam said, but mass screening isn't advisable.  
"Incidence of TB has dropped in many areas — so it isn't really necessary to test people since the rate (to the standard TB test) is so low you wouldn't find many people," said. "It's receded into the shadows."  
Instead, the symposium suggested selective screening of particular parts of a city, with special consideration given to immigrant areas where tuberculosis is prevalent.  
Refugees from Southeast Asia, such as the Vietnamese and Cambodians, Puerto Rico and Cape Verde have a relatively high rate of TB.
