Little River Band to rock in G. Rollie Friday night

While some Aggies will be high-tailing it out of College Station Friday for a final warm weekend on the coast or to Houston to watch for Saturday's A&M-Houston matchup, some students will be waiting to see one of the world's most popular groups, The Little River Band.

Formed in 1975, the five-member band hails from Australia, and made its mark in that country long before America became aware of its fine sounds.

But once the sounds of LRB hit the U.S. airways, there was no turning back, and its fans are now legion.

The group took its name from a sign by the side of an outback road.

Little River Band, the group's first LP, was cut a few months later and catapulted the band to the heights of the Australian music scene.

The members of the band brought many combined years of experience, and the polished performances of lead singer Glenn Shorrock, guitarists Beeb Birtles, David Briggs and Graham Cobles, and drummer Derek Pellicci have won over the hearts of young and old alike.

After Little River Band, the band recorded the successful Diamantina Cocktail, and then struck it big all over the world with Sleeper Catcher. That album became the first album ever to ship platinum in the history of the Australian music industry.

In the summer of 1979, the band was firmly entrenched in the Amer-

ican music scene, and went on its first extensive tour of the United States to plug its new album, Under the Wire. That tour brought several international awards for LRB.

Not only that, LRB took cuts from its recorded North American tour, and cut its latest album, Backstage Pass, in 1980.

Now, the group begins its major tour of the U.S., and appear on stage in College Station along with The Dirt Band, a band that has survived the year an early start as The Nitty Gritty Band.

The concert will begin at 8 p.m. Friday in G. Rollie White Coliseum and there are some general admission tickets remaining.

MSC to honor person of week
