State Fair rides not fun for some

DALLAS — Ride operators at the State Fair of Texas seem to be having more problems this year than any in the recent past.
About 50 people went into a 25 mph spin for about 10 minutes Saturday after a hydraulic pump malfunctioned on a ride called Enterprise. Though no one was injured, 32 complained of nauseous wobbly knees. Authorities said the ride would be shut down until repaired.
In another incident Saturday, a 32-year-old Dallas man fell 25 ft after losing his balance while apparently standing on a roller coaster called Super Zyklon.
Police said Dale Douglas struck a couple of supporting struts behind the ground. Police said Douglas refused to get into an ambulance called to the scene.
On Thursday, a 28-year-old woman was thrown from the Himalaya ride and her mother complained the ride did not close after the incident. The woman suffered a broken wrist and a cut on her hand.
Fair manager Wayne Gallagher, however, says the Himalaya ride, the midway is one of the safest because the operator installed safety belts as an added precaution.
Gallagher said safety precautions on rides are left almost entirely to ride operators and the fair has no official rules for ride safety.
A man was killed and 17 persons were injured last year during a fair when a gondola of the swiss sky ride fell to the ground. The ride closed this year.
