Earlier this month rangers disco vered the remains of a Texas makilled by a grizzly. That bear has not been found.

Eight feet tall on its hind legs, the average grizzly weighs up to 80 pounds and some males even exce ,000 pounds. The grizzly is a biolo gical powerhouse that develops massive strength, quickness and and carrun at speeds of up to 25 mph.
