

United Press International AUSTIN (UPI) — The University Texas Law School has established Children's Rights Clinic to repreent children whose parents are acused of abuse or neglect, university ficials said Monday.

The clinic is financed by a \$40,086 ant from the U.S. Office of Education. A 1979 amendment to the Family Law Code requires that attorneys be appointed to represent children in such cases but the law made no provision for paying the
