Students' excuses — 'juvenile'

If you happen to miss a day of class and you want an excused absence, one way of getting it is by obtaining an excuse from the A.P. Beutel Health Center.
"If a student comes over here and asks for a class excuse we don't question him for being honest," Dr. C. B. Goswick, director of the health center, said. "Or if he's here and has been seen in the clinic and he asks for an excuse, we give it to him."
Professors question the excuses all the time, he said. "As far as I'm concerned the responsibility is theirs anyway."
"I think they (the excuses) are juvenile and degrading to students," Goswick said.
"I mean, really, it's like taking a note from mother when you go back to the first grade class after you've missed a day or something. That's just not fit for around here."
According to Texas A&M University Regulations, it is a student's responsibility to provide evidence to the instructor to substantiate the reason for the absence.
When an absence is authorized, the instructor can provide the student an opportunity to make up tests, assignments or other work missed or else provide a satisfactory alternative.
There are extenuating circumstances that nobody can anticipate, but it should be between the professor and the student to make an adjustment, Goswick said.
"Now surely, if a student had acute appendicitis or had his leg broken or something like that, and say he missed his first exam and something happened to make him miss another one, surely that professor would understand the situation and would make some kind of adjustment and let him make it up," he said.
