"It's unusual that it is observed almost all over the United States," Grider said. "It's a holiday that is totally traditional and not spon-sored by anyone."

"Hallowe'en, as it is spelled correctly, means All Hallow's Even-ing," Grider said. The traditional holiday has ancient pre-Christian origin, possibly with the Celtic tribes of England and Western Europe, she said.

ghosts, she said. The carving of pumpkins is to create the jack-o-lantern, who is a goblin — a wandering ghost — or the spirit of an ancestor," Grider "Trick-or-treat is ritual begging that was done by students to get money or food in the Middle Ages in Europe.

Bobbing for apples symbolizes baptism when the person trying to catch the apple puts his head under water.

All these traits of Halloween exemplify its ancient origin and his-tory, Grider said.
