


Dallas grabs dramatic win

United Press International ST. LOUIS — Fighting to hold back the tears, St. Louis cornerback Roger Wehrli tried to explain the desperation pass in the end zone that gave the Dallas Cowboys a dramatic 27-24 victory Sunday over the Car-

"Tony Hill did a good job of screening me off from the ball with his back," said Wehrli. "I should have figured out a way to get around him, but I couldn't. It all happened

In a patented Dallas finish, the Cowboys were trailing 24-20 when they got the ball back at their own 31-yard line with 1:52 left on the clock and two timeouts.
