## 'Brujeras' fun; not satisfying

When Rafael and Petra clutched their crucifix, cried and prayed in hysterical fear, I was convinced there was a witch in their house. But when Aunt Olga easily told them they were only hearing noises in the night, I was disappointed there wasn't a witch in their house. El Teatro de la Esperanza's production of "Brujeras" was, in a word, anti-climactic. The MSC Committee for the Awareness of Mexican American Culture brought the California-based theater group to Rudder Theater Friday night.

"Brujeras," "Superstitions" in English, is a one-act bilingual comedy written by Rodrigo Duarte-Clark. The script gave an excellent mixture of Spanish and English which let the audience follow the story even without catching every word.

Ruby Nelda Perez was delightful in her role as Petra. Ruperto Reyes Jr. played Rafael and Anna I. Olivarez played Tia Olga. Before the play, Jose Luis Valenzuela's smooth, rich voice entertained with several Spanish songs which he accompanied with guitar. Valenzuela is also a member of El Teatro.

The two main Chicano actors vivaciously carried the audience through an elderly couple's comic bickering and terrified outbursts.

When Petra criticized her husband's fear of the strange whistling and scratching noises they heard at home one night, she amused the audience with repeatedly calling him a "Shicken."

Once Petra herself became afraid, she dropped to her knees and prayed hysterically, which received laughter from the audience several times.

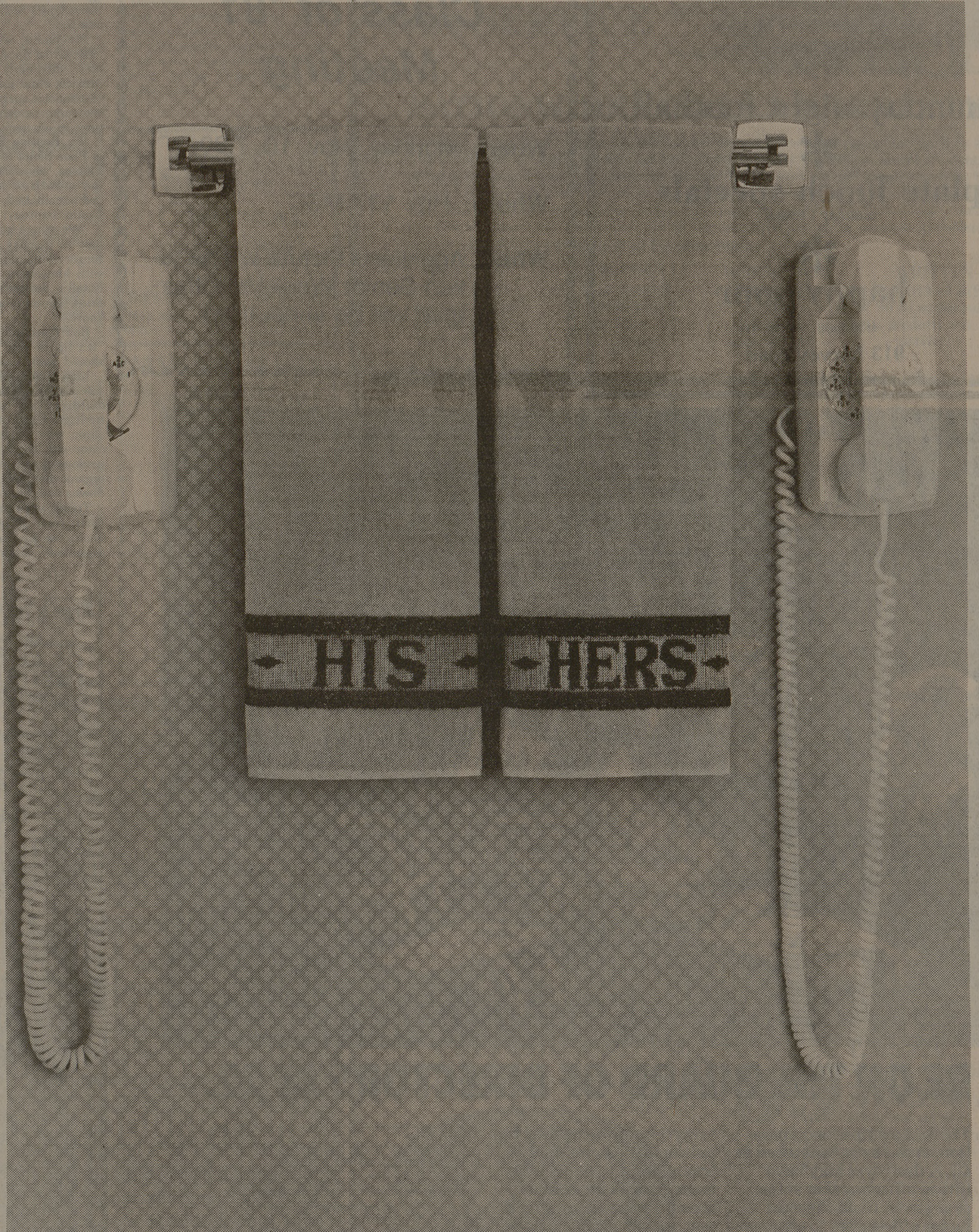
Such actions demonstrated the human inclination to pray in times of fear. Similarly, the audience chuckled when Rafael panicked because he hadn't been to church in several years. "Brujeras" humorously, and realistically, showed how close people get to their God when they're afraid.

But after experiencing all the fear and the fun, the mystery and the madness, that came with the belief that a witch was haunting the house, the audience was deprived of an appropriately humorous explanation of the frightening noises.

While Rafael and Petra had been obsessed with their brujerías, they were too quick to accept Tia Olga's explanation that the suspect woman was not a bruja, not a witch, but an amiga, a friend of hers. Olga herself had earlier advised them to sprinkle Holy water around their house to keep the witch away. Later however, when the couple returned for more advice, she laughed at them for being afraid.

Unfortunately for the audience, they easily realized their foolishness and went back home to bed.

Disappointed, I went home and did the same.
