ls Credit up despite bad news

WASHINGTON — Consumers have dusted
Their credit cards and resumed their old borwing habits — another sign the recession is er, although trends on the unemployment and flation fronts remain grim.

The Federal Reserve Board — the nation's cen-al bank — said Friday that for the second month a row, consumers borrowed more money than eyrepaid, indicating the public is slowly regain-g confidence in the economy.

Two government reports issued the same day ow that despite the economy's slow recovery, flation and unemployment resumed their up-ard spiral in October following dips in both ategories in September.

The Labor Department said unemployment se 0.1 percent to 7.6 percent in October and holesale prices of consumer goods rose 0.8 perent last month.

Neither figure surprised government and pri-ate analysts, who noted the jobless rate typically ises at the beginning of a recovery period when

The producer price index now stands at 252.2, meaning those goods that cost \$100 to produce in 1967 now cost \$252.20.

Prices for consumer foods also moved up 0.5 percent over the month, after edging down 0.2 percent in September. They mainly reflected a large increase in sugar prices.

The unemployment level for adult men dropped to 6.4 percent in October — the first time since April that it has been outside the narrow range of 6.6 percent to 6.7 percent.
