Black farm owners close to extinction

GREENSBORO, N.C. — Black farm owners are facing extinction by the end of the century if current trends hold, a state Agricultural Extension Program worker says.

The amount of black-owned land has dwindled from a high of 15 million acres in 1910 to less than 6 million acres in 1978. The Emergency Land Fund, a non-profit group based in Atlanta, estimates Southern blacks are losing up to 9,000 acres of farm land a week.

Small farm owners in general have come upon hard times in recent years and state Agriculture Commissioner James Graham says blacks are not the only group affected. Others claim that black farmers are victims of racial discrimination.

Experts give several reasons for the declining amount of black farm land:

- Black farmers, often educated, fail to keep accurate records, buy insurance or write wills when they die, the land often is equally among their children, the process continues through generations until the plots are too small for each descendant to successfully.
- Children of black farmers move to the city and have no interest in becoming farmers.
- Farm land is being used for other uses, driving up the price making it impossible for blacks to purchase the extra acreage for large-scale farming.
- Some charge that another factor, saying white owners refuse to sell to blacks.
