AUSTIN — Sen. Lloyd Doggett, D-Austin, started action Monday on a bill that might give state employees an emergency pay raise as early as February.

"Unless we pay state employees appropriate salaries, we'll continue to experience a 30 percent turnover rate," he said.

**Bad habits
causing
head lice**

TULSA, Okla. — The last infestation that forced Tulsa University to shut down for a week was the fumigation of the campus on Monday unless students improve their personal hygiene habits, according to health officials.
All classes were canceled for two days as exterminators sprayed buildings and dormitories. Health officials hoped the itchy problem would be over when the students returned to campus Monday.
Dr. Fred Reynolds, an administrator of the Tulsa City-County Health Department said the problem was caused by students' poor hygiene habits — or a lack of head lice prevention.
"If students who move to Liliama's fumigated dorms still have the problem, it will reappear," he said.
"University officials have fumigated all buildings on campus above and beyond the call of diamonds," Reynolds said.
More than 200 of the university's 1,550 students lined up on Monday and Friday at the school's special shampoo station to have their hair washed.
Jim Lamb, school spokesman, said the university ran out of shampoo very quickly, and an over-the-counter shampoo, and an additional 1,500 were flown in from another state.
He said the school has completed "thousands of dollars" worth of exterminator services.
"It is mostly a problem of lice infestation," Reynolds said. "It was jump or fly, but instead of being transmitted through combs, clothes or hats, it was transmitted through clothing or bedclothes of people who are infested."

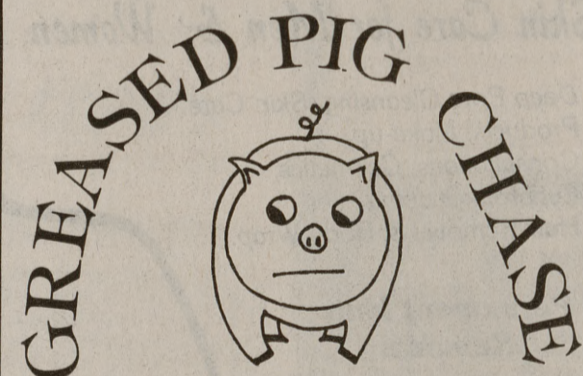

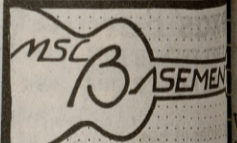
