To be eligible to order, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. 1. A record check must be made for eligibility determination. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, no later than November 21st. This may not be done by phone.

No opposition to Pemex lawsuit

WASHINGTON — United Press International — The Carter administration has told a federal judge it does not oppose a Texas firm's effort to make Mexico's state oil company face \$375 million in damage claims for the world's worst spill.
The sensitive foreign policy decision was disclosed in legal papers filed in U.S. District Court in Houston last week — just before Attorney General Benjamin Civiletti left on an apparently unrelated week-long trip to Mexico City.
The Ixtoc I drilling platform blew out in the Gulf of Mexico in 1979, spouting more than 100 million gallons of oil and damaging Texas and Louisiana coasts before it was largely brought under control three months later.
Sedco Inc., an oil company based in Corpus Christi that supplied the drilling platform to the Mexicans has been named as defendant in consolidated damage suits — with claims totaling upwards of \$1 billion — filed on behalf of fishermen, resorts, the state of Texas and the federal government.
But Sedco contends it was not at fault for the platform's failure. It has filed a "third party complaint" to make the Mexican national company, Pemex, and a private Mexican drilling firm, Pemexco, codefendants in damage suits stemming from the 1979 spill.
In a court brief filed last week, Justice Department lawyers said they saw no basis for objecting to Sedco's attempt to do bring the Mexicans into the case.
Lawyers for Pemex, who have asked U.S. District Judge Robert O'Connor Jr. to disallow the third-party complaint, contend Sedco's move would be an embarrassment to the United States in its relations with Mexico since the administration has not filed state
