1969 death might be toxic shock

Hill, whose mysterious death in 1969 led to a book and now a tele movie, tends to indicate that she did not die of toxic shock syndro medical examiner says.

Hill died at age 38 of what was then ruled a massive infection three-day illness, she suffered vomiting, diarrhea, high fever at drop in blood pressure. Toxic shock syndrome was unknown at

Her husband, Dr. John Hill, was prosecuted for alleged murder his first wife by neglect but his first trial ended in mistrial. He was to death in a 1972 contract killing before he could be retried. A third Mrs. Hill filed a civil suit trying to link Joan Robinson father, oilman Ash Robinson, to the killing of the husband, butae jury cleared him.

"It (Mrs. Hill's death) doesn't fit the pattern, in my opinion," He County Medical Examiner Dr. Joseph Jachimczyk said. "Therewas demonstrable significant bacteria growth that is present in the 1001. CBS-TV News Saturday quoted John Hill's defense lawyer, Ri

'Racehorse" Haynes, as saying he believed toxic shock syndry The network also quoted Dr. Paul Radelat, who participated exhumation autopsy on Mrs. Hill, as saying she might have die toxic shock syndrome, although he said it could not be known

Jachimczyk agreed Hill had some symptoms but not others. He toxic shock victims have gram positive bacteria in their bodies. Hes Hill had gram negative bacteria in her body.
