The deadline for ordering the Texas A&M senior class ring this semester is **December 5, 1980**. To be eligible to order, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. To order please note the following instructions:

1. A record check must be made for eligibility determination. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, no later than **November 21st**. This may not be done by phone.
2. Please allow one and a half weeks for the record check to be made.
3. If mid-term grades are needed to complete any of the above requirements, please bring them along when ready to order. If you no longer have a copy, they may be obtained from your department or advisor.
4. All ring must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior ring loans are available through the student financial aid office, YMCA building.
5. Orders are taken between 8:00-11:30 am and 1:00-4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
6. Rings ordered between October 27th and December 5th will be delivered approximately March 12, 1980.

(Orders are also being taken for graduate students receiving degrees in December '80. In addition to a record check, the \$11.00 graduation fee receipt must be presented to the ring clerk when ordering.) 56113

## Firetruck answer 2 calls here

The College Station Fire Department answered two calls to the A&M University campus minutes apart Tuesday afternoon.

A fire department spokesman said a call came in at 1:40 p.m. for a fire in the Chemistry Building. Another call to the Academy building came in at 1:50.

A smoke detector was triggered in the Chemistry Building by a student who was smoking in the area, it, Edward Kozlowski, assistant director for maintenance and a call manager of plant operations said Tuesday afternoon.

The call from the Academy building was called in directly to the department by someone attending a building after a fluorescent light started smoking. Kozlowski said the Chemistry Building's smoke detector signaled an alarm. Physical Plant's central alarm and the dispatcher called an alarm to the College Station apartment, Kozlowski said.

The call was relayed immediately, largely because of a fire in the Biological Sciences building. That fire caused an estimated \$75,000-100,000 damage to a search laboratory, Robert Texas A&M University spokesman said.

Fire alarms are "a sensitive" since the biology lab fire, Kozlowski said.

Kozlowski said maintenance workers fixed the smoking light in the Academic Building before it set off a smoke alarm, but "some of the building" must have smoked and called the fire department.

A fire department spokesman said three fire engines and an ambulance responded to the calls.

**Burned boy gets million from gas suit**

HOUSTON — A 14-year-old boy with burns over 90 percent of his body will receive \$1.7 million and \$6,000 per month plus for the rest of his life in an approved settlement with a company.

An October 1977 fire killed Herzog's brothers, Brian Herzog and Clayton Herzog, 7, and maternal grandparents, Mary Dorothy Swonke of rural Texas. Steven spent seven months in Houston and Galveston hospital treatment of his third-degree burns. He lost his fingers and toes and scar tissue over 90 percent of his body. Doctors reconstructed thumbs for him and he is attending school for more than a year.

State District Judge Reagan Wright Monday approved the settlement, which also calls for his guardian to receive \$68,000 in installments of varying amounts every five years beginning when Steven turns 25. Steven's parents, Charles Herzog, and an ex-wife, Donald Swonke, will receive \$1 million for the death of the dren and grandparents.

The settlement was reached before the damage suit was filed.

According to lawsuit documents, a naturally odorous gas had not been properly ordered by law so that it was not detected. The gas concentrated in the Swonke house and was ignited by a water heater, the suit said.

Agreeing to the settlement, Coastal State Gas Corp., a subsidiary of Texasaco Inc. and Atlantic field Co. Dudley Oldham, a spokesman for Coastal, said the settlement is "fair to everybody's standpoint" and was a compromise reached after lengthy and expensive trial.

Oldham said Coastal will provide propane, some of which was from a field owned by Mobil and ARCO. A lawyer for Mobil, none of the defendants admitted fault in reaching the settlement.
