Corps to sing for women

All the practice that members of the Texas A&M Corps of Cadets have gotten singing and chanting on outfit runs may pay off tonight as they take to the women's dorms Christmas carolling.

Previously underclassmen in the Corps have carolled at Spence and Briggs halls on the Corps Quad, but this year they also will be traveling to the Commons and North Area dorms, Corps Operations Sgt. Brent Gunter said.
The songfest will take place from

10-10:30 p.m. and the cadets' repertoire will feature only traditional Christmas carols, not the modified versions composed by some outfits' underclassmen for serenading upperclassmen.
Freshmen and sophomores singing to upperclassmen has developed more or less into a Corps tradition, Gunter said, but the validity of the tunes as Christmas carols could easily be questioned.

In more cases than not, the carols aren't the type most children learn in elementary school music classes nor would most cadets want to sing them in church, he said.

But, Gunter said, the cadets will stick to the more familiar Christmas tunes when carolling at the women's dorms this year.

"They're going to sing traditional carols; they'd better," he said.

Gunter said the idea to carol across campus this year came about as an attempt to let the rest of the University know what the Corps is like and "to let them know we are over here."

Marijuana seized near High Island

NAHUAC — Sheriff's deputies seized 12,500 pounds of marijuana apparently unloaded from a vessel on the Intracoastal Waterway and arrested one man, Sheriff Doil Pounds said.

Pounds withheld the suspect's name and said Tuesday the investigation was expected to produce more arrests.

Pounds said deputies staged the raid before sunrise Tuesday beneath a Farm Road 124 bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway near High Island. He said a state game warden overheard radio conversations about pot smuggling.

Pounds said several persons, a truck and the boat fled as deputies closed in, but deputies seized a rented truck loaded with the pot when the truck became stuck in the mud.

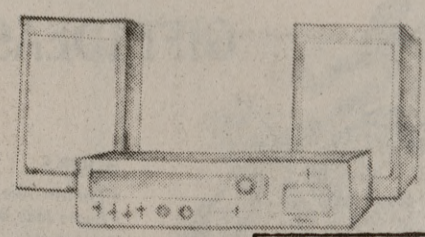
