

The law, which stipulates those who aid in a felony are as guilty as the person who commits the act, led to felony murder charges against John Cochran, 18 and a 17-year-old youth who accompanied him. His 16-yearold brother James was killed during the weekend

State law says a killing that occurs during the commission of a felony or an attempt to commit a felony is firstdegree murder.

Crawford County Attorney Mike McCurdy argued that the two teenagers had committed a felony in planning the attempted robbery, a killing occurred, so they should be charged with murder.
