AUSTIN — Reacting to a stepped-up campaign against legal abortion in Texas and in the nation, five groups favoring legal abortions have said the freedom to choose whether to bear children is in jeopardy.

Speaking for the Texas Women's Political Caucus, Kathy Barrett said Friday, "the freedom of choosing whether or not to bear children is in serious jeopardy."

"There are those persons — highly visible in recent days — who would force their individual beliefs upon every citizen," she said. "These people are storming the Legislature in an effort to limit the choices of every person."

Four other groups were represented at the meeting, including the Texas Civil Liberties Union, the National Organization for Women, the Texas Abortion Rights Action League and the Rosie Jimenez Fund.

Asked about a comment by Sen. Walter Mengden, R-Houston, that some abortions are "for cosmetic, non-medical reasons," Jan Friese of the Texas Abortion Rights Action League said, "I find it offensive and an insult to everyone undergoing her own personal trauma. It's an insult to everyone."

Mengden has introduced bills to prohibit funds to pay for abortions and to require parental consent for teenage abortions.

"Basically, this bill says that if there are going to be legal abortions for cosmetic, nonmedical reasons,

then they will have to be done on a free enterprise basis, rather than socialized medicine basis," Mengden said Friday. "If someone wants an abortion for convenience sake, they pay for it out of their pockets."

Friese, representing the group she called the only statewide organization solely concerned with the protection of reproductive rights of Texas women, called abortion a personal issue.

"We're talking about privacy, religious freedom, imposition of religious values on people who do not necessarily share those values," she said. "We're talking about health, not just female."

Gloria Sprinkle, speaking for the National Organization for Women, said the "Human Life Amendment" which would give constitutional rights to human beings from the moment of conception, is "anti-family and anti-family planning."

"It would give the government the right to decide whether, when, and how many of our children to have," Sprinkle said. "Americans everywhere are opposed to government interference in the lives. The HLA would thrust the government into an individual's private life."

Pam Fridrich, representing the Rosie Jimenez Fund, announced the creation of a fund to pay for abortions for poor women. The Hyde Amendment cut off most Medicaid payments for abortions.

7,000-volt shock hits Dallas man

DALLAS — Brent Burns joked Sunday about being "Reddy Kilowatt," an electric utility company's fictional mascot, but the construction worker realizes he's lucky to be alive.

Burns, 25, and two other construction workers were jolted with 7,600 volts of electricity Friday at a construction site. The current passed through Burns' body and exited through the bottom of his foot, leaving a wound the size of a quarter. He suffered burns on his back and legs.

"It was a nightmare," he said. Burns was lying on a concrete slab with the hose from a concrete pump draped over his right shoulder.

"There's a boom on the pump," he said. "I guess the boom hit some high wires. All I felt was the shock. It hit me real hard. I couldn't let go of the pump. I looked down and saw my pants leg smoking, and I passed out. When I fell down I thought I was dead."

Pete Ramirez, 44, saw his coworker clinging to the pump handle and pried him loose with a shovel. Then Ramirez got shocked. He suffered burns and a broken foot.

"I wasn't breathing. Someone gave me mouth-to-mouth resuscitation," Burns said.

Doctors told Burns it would be several months before he could work on his injured foot, but the immediate disappointment for Burns was being confined to viewing the Super Bowl from a hospital bed — without the aid of a can of beer.

DALLAS — Alvin Cornelius' need was simple: a place to sleep protected from the cold night air.

Cornelius said the Union Gospel Mission downtown was full Friday. So he walked a few blocks and found warm comfort in a trash dumpster.

He said he was sleeping peacefully when a garbage truck picked up the dumpster and collected the trash and Cornelius.

"I screamed, but no one heard me," he said. With each collection the truck made, Cornelius was compressed with the garbage.

"I thought I was a dead man. I didn't expect to come out of this alive," he said.

He was pressed into a truck-cube of trash and deposited in a private landfill south of Dallas. An employee saw Cornelius and called an ambulance.

Though squeezed several times during the night, Cornelius suffered only a fractured arm.

Come snow, sleet or worse, Cornelius said, "I won't sleep in a dumpster tonight."

Bess Truman released from hospital

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Former first lady Bess Truman was released "completely healed" at midday Saturday from the hospital that has been treating her skin irritation for more than three weeks.

Dr. Wallace Graham, the Truman family physician, said the skin problem that put Truman in Research Medical Center Dec. 30 was "completely healed." He said she left with her Secret Service detail at 11:30 a.m. CST, and returned to her home on Delaware Street in Independence.

"Mrs. Truman is in better condition than she has been in the last several weeks," Graham said. "She was very happy to be going home, and she even gave me a salute."

The nation's oldest surviving first lady at 95 — she will be 96 on Feb. 13 — will not require a special nurse, doctors said, but only routine care.

Truman has rarely left her home since the 33rd president — Harry Truman — died Dec. 26, 1972.
