### Rosen now relieved

HOUSTON — Houston Astros General Manager Al Rosen said amid confusion by the team's many owners Wednesday that he was relieved the storm of publicity over Tal Smith's firing as general manager might subside.

"Now you fellows (sports media) can all concentrate on baseball and I won't have to pick up the paper every other day and let myself get nicked," Rosen said from his home, where he is recuperating from a single-bypass heart operation.

He referred to criticism from fans and media leveled at Astros principal owner John McMullen since McMullen's firing Oct. 27 of General Manager Smith three days following the team's most successful season and a week before Smith was named Major League executive of the year.

Rosen, McMullen's choice to replace Smith, has said or done no-

thing since he took the job to incur criticism. He has tried to improve the team by signing free agents Don Sutton and Dave Roberts, pitcher Bob Knepper (in a trade for third baseman Enos Cabell) and several Astros regulars.

"I've never been one to gloat in victory or go down hard in defeat, but I am delighted this is behind me," said Rosen.

He was reacting to Smith's statements Tuesday that Smith had been informed by one of three Astros directors a decision had been made not to rehire him. The decision, apparently verbal, was reportedly obtained by McMullen in exchange for agreeing to a new corporate setup in which he gave up full control.

McMullen, reached at his Montclair, N.J., home late Tuesday, said no vote had been taken on the Smith matter because the new corporation had not been formed.

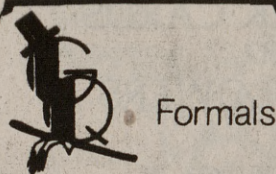

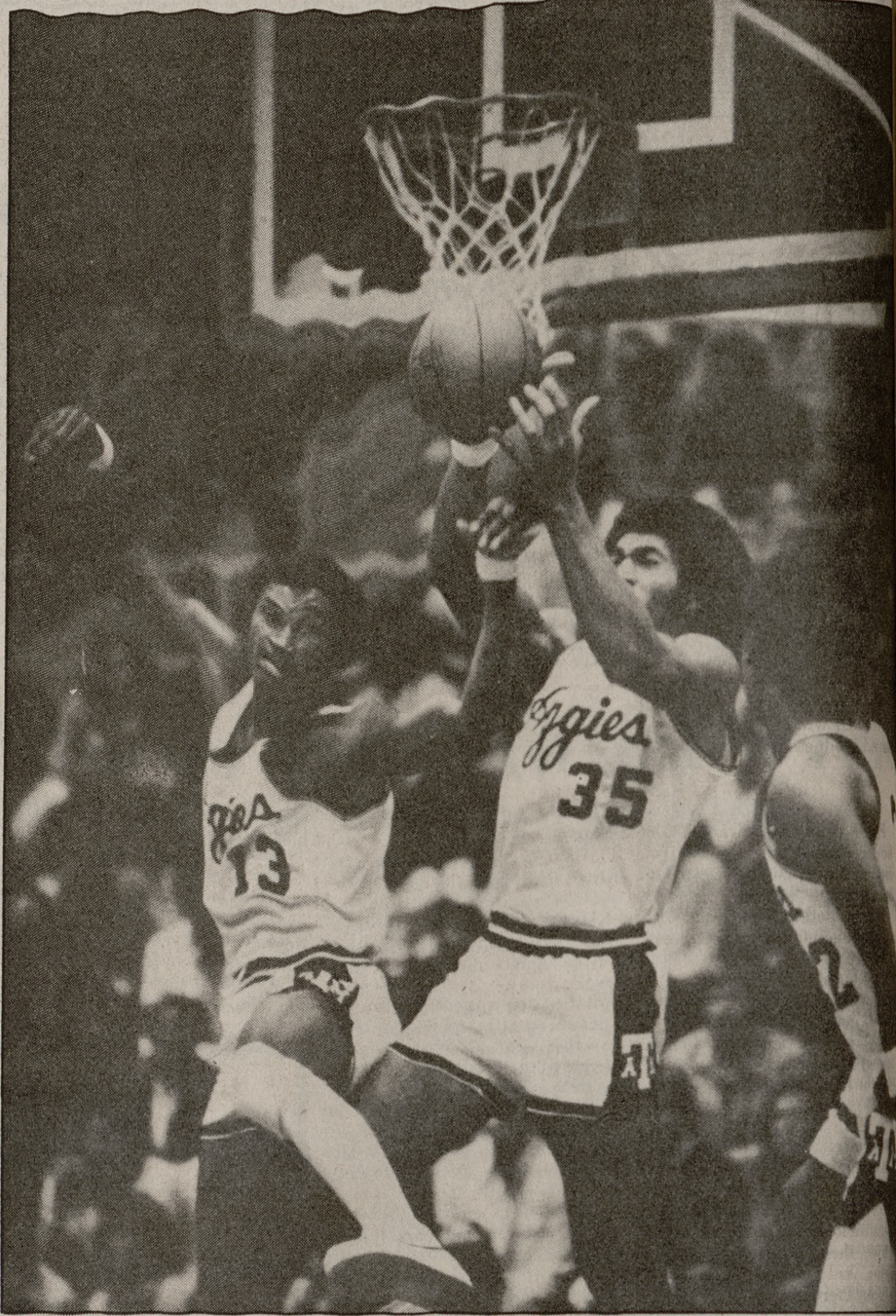

## Phillips hires 5 assistants as New Orleans rebuilds

NEW ORLEANS — Saints head coach Bum Phillips Wednesday added to his coaching staff five assistants — one a former Texas A&M

University fullback — whom he said offered a variety of backgrounds.

Phillips appointed King Hill as offensive coordinator, Willie Zapalac to handle the defensive line, Harold

Richardson to head the special teams, Joe Spencer to coach offensive backfield and John Paul Young to oversee linebackers.

Wade Phillips, Bum's son, was announced as defensive coordinator.

"We will add a defensive secondary coach, a receiver's coach and offensive backfield coach to complete the staff," Phillips said.

Hill came to New Orleans from the Houston Oilers, Phillips' team, where he served as coach of the quarterbacks and receivers, played quarterback in the NFL, 12 seasons with St. Louis, Philadelphia and Minnesota.

Zapalac coached the defensive line for the Buffalo Bills before moving to New Orleans. He also held that position with St. Louis. He was a fullback at Texas A&M and later coached there, as well as at OSU and the University of Texas.

Richardson served as defensive coordinator for North Texas State before joining the Saints. He also has been an assistant coach at Texas Christian University, Oklahoma State University and Southern Methodist University.

Spencer had been with the Kansas City Chiefs for six seasons before being hired by Phillips. He also was offensive line coach for the Houston Oilers, New York Jets and St. Louis Cardinals. Spencer coached the offensive line in their Super Bowl III upset of Baltimore.

Young also coached for the Oilers, beginning his career under Phillips in 1962. He was a four-year starter and linebacker at Texas-El Paso and was a defensive coordinator at Jacksonville, Texas, high school before coaching at SMU, OSU and Texas A&M.

The hirings leave only three positions unfilled on the Saints' staff.

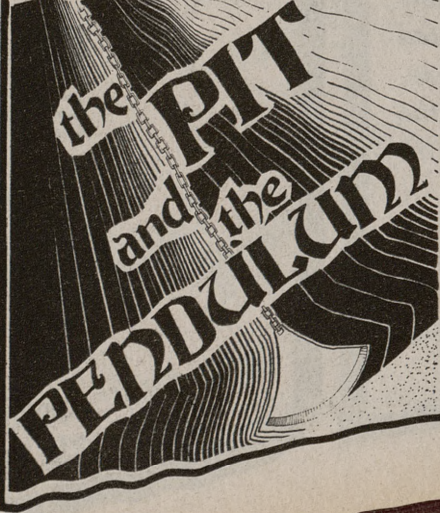
