## Trigamist faces fine, jail for theft

SEATTLE — A middle-aged warehouse worker accused of mauling at least three women and running off with their money pleaded guilty Tuesday to charges of first degree theft involving one of the victims.  
Superior Court Judge H. Joseph Coleman set a March 4 sentencing date for Richard George Kirkman, 53, who faces up to 10 years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.  
Kirkman, who also goes by the name Larry Kenneth Shelton, allegedly courted and married a Seattle law firm para-professional, then fled the area with \$10,000 she had invested in a firm she helped him set up, said Pat Sainsbury, an attorney in the fraud division of the King County prosecutor's office.  
Sainsbury said Kirkman is accused of pulling off a similar scheme with a Houston woman and one from Albuquerque, N.M.  
Kirkman was arrested Dec. 22 while traveling to Salisbury, N.C. to meet the Albuquerque woman's parents, the attorney said. At the time he was driving a vehicle paid for by his Seattle wife, Sainsbury said.  
In Seattle, Kirkman allegedly told his new spouse he wanted to set up a business as a freight expeditor and purchaser to deal with clients in Alaska. Sainsbury said the wife helped him prepare corporation papers, opened up a bank account in both their names and deposited \$10,000.  
She also was persuaded to trade in a 1976 model car for a 1980 model and to borrow money to make up the difference, he said. The new wife was recovered during the arrest in North Carolina.  
In Houston, Kirkman allegedly married another woman and told her he wanted to open an auto parts store. However, Sainsbury said there was a falling out over an investment plan and Kirkman left suddenly but not before taking the woman's jewelry and an old coin collection.  
Police finally caught up with the marrying marauder after a roommate of his third wife decided to check on the ownership of his car through its license plates. Sainsbury said the roommate contacted the Seattle victim, who told police the couple was traveling to North Carolina.

## Arkansas man killed at sorority dinner

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. — A University of Arkansas freshman terrorizing a sorority initiation dinner at gunpoint, apparently because he had been spurned for a date, was shot and killed by police in front of about 100 coeds.  
Some of the women attending Tuesday night's dinner at the Delta Delta Delta sorority house giggled until they realized the young man was serious about shooting.  
Police said they tried to talk James Taylor, 19, of North Little Rock, into surrendering, but opened fire after he aimed his shotgun at sorority members in sorority's dining room.  
One member said Taylor apparently was upset with a woman who had refused to date him.  
Witnesses said Taylor parked his car in a lot behind a row of sorority houses and pulled a shotgun out of the back seat. A resident of a nearby sorority house saw the gun and called city police, who notified campus security.  
"He knocked on the door, and since it was right in the middle of an initiation dinner, a house boy had to let him in," said sorority member Mary Lee Hewitt of Springdale, Ark. "He walked in and was holding the gun on his shoulder, like something out of the Army."  
"He motioned to the girls asked for a date to come over to his house. Some of the girls were giggling because they didn't know whether to take it seriously."  
The house boy, Mitch Lynn, senior from North Little Rock, he talked Taylor into putting the gun outside, witnesses said, but Taylor refused.  
"The house boy went over to the house and he'd put the gun outside," he said, "None, there's going to be some shooting tonight," Hewitt said.  
At about that time, three police officers, also armed with shotguns, entered the front door and two other armed policemen entered the house through a back door, police said.  
Police confronted Taylor in the foyer and he aimed the gun at the momentarily, university officials said. Then he walked to the partition, flung it open and pointed a cocked shotgun at sorority members who were scurrying out of the room.  
The girls sought cover and police opened fire, hitting Taylor in the head and chest, university officials said. He was pronounced dead at Washington Regional Medical Center.
