## Transplant causes death

United Press International CLEVELAND — A 10-month-old boy who underwent a bone marrow transplant last week in an attempt to treat a usually fatal bone disease died today, hospital officials announced. Kamran Fazili, who was suffering from infantile malignant osteopetrosis, or marble bone disease, had been in the pediatric intensive care unit at Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital. The infant, reportedly doing well following the Jan. 20 transplant of bone marrow from a woman from London, died of acute respiratory failure, doctors said. "Death occurred following complications from the intensive chemotherapy and radiation therapy necessary to prepare the infant for transplantation," said Dr. Peter J. Coccia, the hospital's acting director of hematology-oncology. "It was too early following transplantation to assess whether the bone marrow was functioning," Coccia said.

## Suit filed against company

United Press International CONROE — A \$5 million lawsuit against a Delaware baby formula company was filed by a Dallas couple who said the baby food caused physical injuries to their son. Steven and Patricia Burnett, formerly of Conroe and now living in the Dallas area, said in their suit Tuesday that the formula Neo-mull-soy, manufactured by Syntex Laboratories Inc., caused their son Braden, now 4, to have "a severe and permanent hearing loss, nerve damage and resulting hyperactivity." The Federal Drug Administration removed Neo-mull-soy from the market in 1979 after determining the formula had an insufficient amount of chloride which is vital to the proper development of infants. The formula has since been changed and is on the market again. Numerous lawsuits against Syntex are pending, said Jack Cowley of Dallas, the Burnett's attorney.
