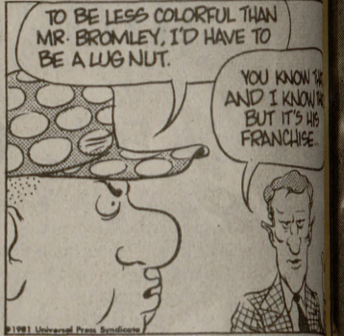
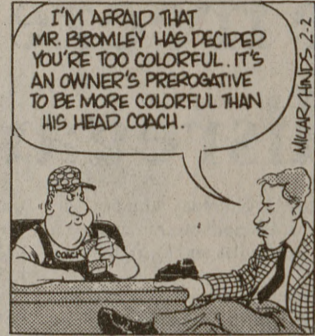
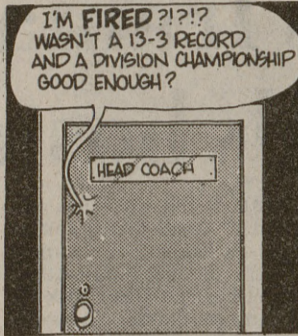

McDaniel thrown off team; Ladson also in 'hot water'

Maurice McDaniel, the 6-8 sophomore who transferred from the University of Florida to join the Texas A&M University basketball team this season, was thrown off the squad during Saturday's game with Baylor by Head Coach Shelby Metcalf.

Aggie guard Tyrone Ladson, after missing practices Thursday and Friday, is also in hot water.

According to team sources, McDaniel, who had to sit out a year before he was eligible, was sent into the game during the second half as Baylor was in a zone press defense.

In that situation, the second guard is designated to throw the ball in from out of bounds after a bucket or foul. McDaniel, however, playing center, mistakenly threw the ball in instead and was removed from the game "to make a correction."

After McDaniel was briefed on his mistake, he was asked to return to the game, but refused. At this point, one member of the team said Metcalf told McDaniel: "Look, we get plenty of people for practice, but we need some to play the games." McDaniel still refused to go back in, and Metcalf told him, "we just can't use you, you're off the team."

When asked after the game if McDaniel had been released from the squad, Metcalf said, "He is as far as I'm concerned."

Another team member, who asked to remain anonymous, said: "After all we've been through this season, it seems to me that if he can't be happy for the team, we can't use him. That's what disappoints me about the whole thing."

One trainer said he found McDaniel's basketball shoes in the trash can in the team dressing room.

McDaniel had seen limited action this season, playing in only two games.

Ladson missed practices Thursday and Friday, and told Metcalf he was injured, but the trainers said the senior guard had not seen them.

Ladson did not dress out for Saturday's contest.

If that game is any indication, however, Milton Woodley will be the best shot at the starting position opposite Reggie Roberts, should Metcalf stay with two guards.

Woodley amazed a packed G. R. lie White crowd by turning in a performance against Baylor, stealing six balls and playing excellent defense.

Lamar beats UTA by five

There was more attention given this affair than to the area Southwest Conference teams and it almost equal billing with the two world records set at a Dallas indoor track meet.

It was Texas-Arlington vs. Lamar and it was a dandy, the Cardinal finally prevailing in overtime, 88-84. "I don't think anyone will ask for their money back," said Texas-Arlington coach Bob "Snake" Leonard after the first meeting of the year between what may be the best teams in Texas.

The Mavericks tied the game in regulation with 10 seconds to go, shot by Danny Johnson and quick shot by Lamar guard Mike Glasco. But Lamar rallied to win its second league game without a loss and assume command in the early going of the Southland Conference race.

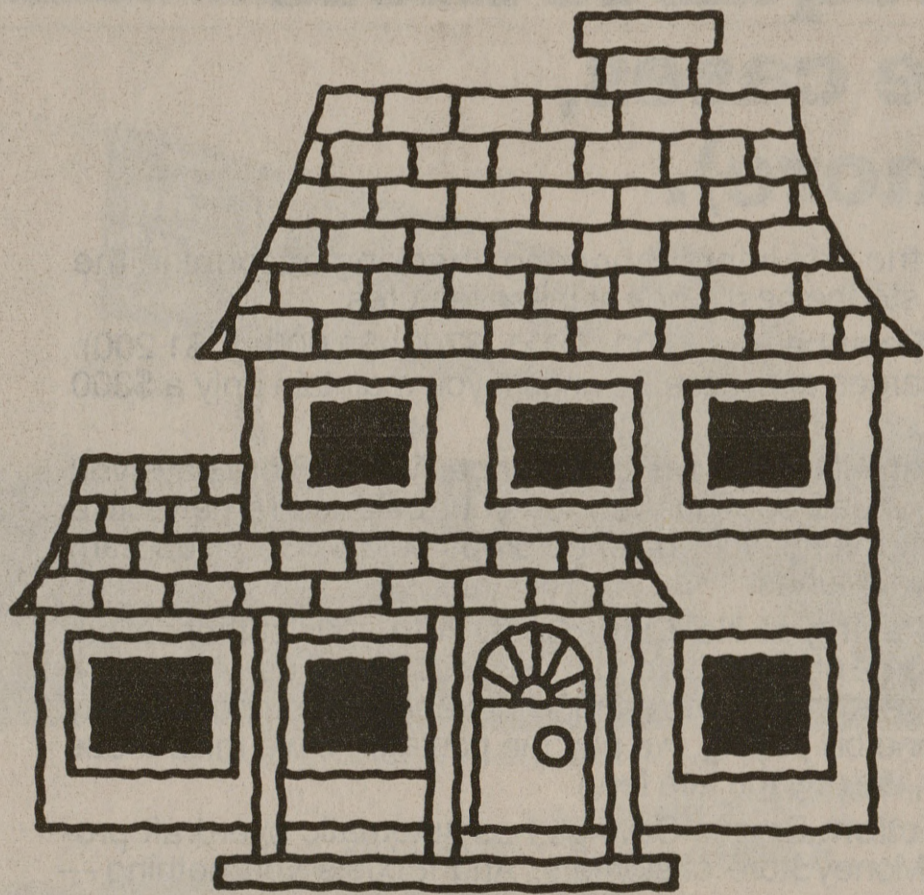

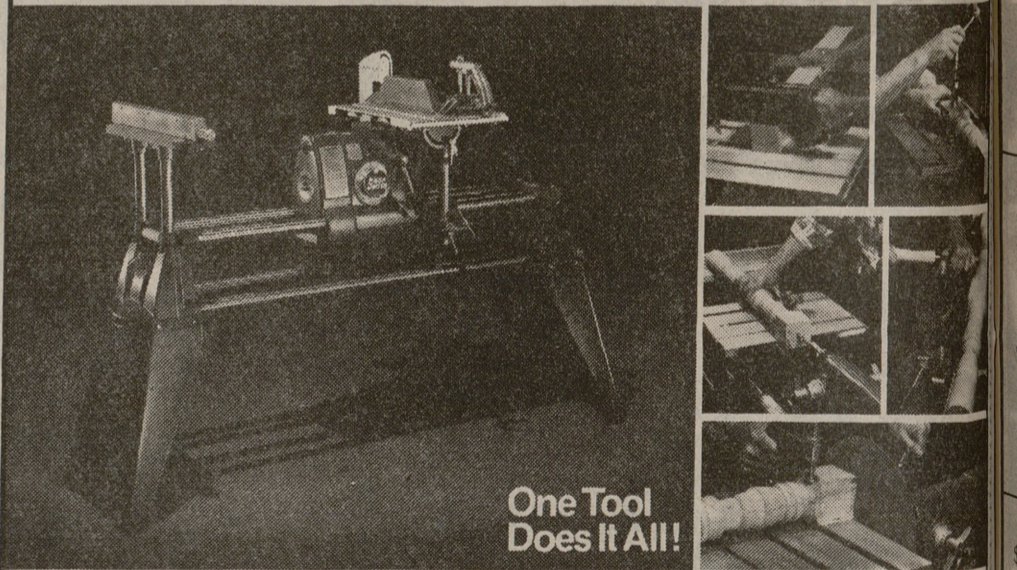
