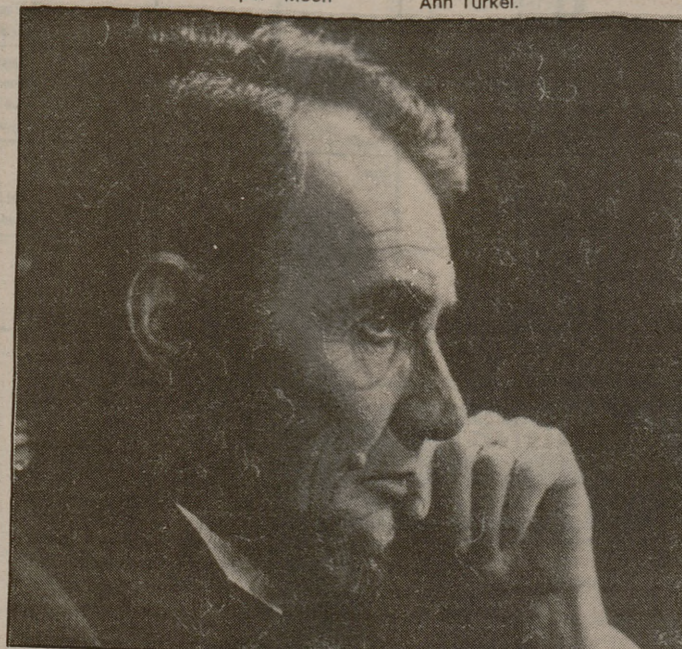
13 ★★½ "Airport 1975" (1974) Charlton Heston, Karen Black.
