**EPA agrees Texas to buy PCB in Mar**

Curtis Bay, Md. — A ware contractor plans to 34,500 gallons of PCB laced with eral combustible substances. Texas incinerator in early March, says a spokesman for the agency charged with the transfer. Coast Guard spokesman Waller said Tuesday that the agency and Rollins Environmental Services Inc., of ington, Del., reached an agreement in principle, although certain procedural matters still must be resolved. The Coast Guard originally predicted the PCB, laced with xylene and benzene and other combustibles, would be moved to Curtis Bay by Labor Day. 1978 delays were encountered in getting permission to burn the PCB at Deer Park, Texas incinerator. PCB, or polychlorinated biphenyls, is a durable substance that is suspected of causing cancer in humans. Its manufacture has been banned in the United States since 1973, although industry and government still uses millions of gallons as a coolant. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency authorized the PCB to be burned at the Texas incinerator last month clearing the way for removal of the Curtis Bay tons. "Before it can be finalized, the will submit a final detailed report about two weeks," Waller said. The point (still unresolved) involved the determination of manpower and equipment during removal — logging. Sealed drums of PCB have been stored since February 1980 at storage depot. The material was discovered abandoned tank farm in Sharnock on the Eastern Shore. Residents who feared the PCB would leach into the rusting tanks into the nearby Antioche River, a prime breeding ground, persuaded the Coast Guard to move the PCB. The PCB-laced waste oil was brought to Curtis Bay after a long dispute between the Coast Guard and Anne Arundel County officials. Residents feared harm to the environment would result if the PCB somehow released into the environment.

**Woman aided by boyfriend not universal**

WICHITA, Kan. — A newspaper reported Wednesday that a woman who moved out of a low-income district when her son began playing ketball at Wichita State University received financial help from boyfriend, not from the university. A copyright story in Wednesday's edition of the Wichita Eagle-Beacon reported that the boyfriend of Jody Carr was a winner in a \$1 million malpractice settlement in 1979. The year that her son, Antoine Carr, rolled at WSU. Stories in the Kansas City Times had implied that Carr was able to move from a low-rent district to a \$62,500 home because of financial help from the Missouri Valley College school and its boosters. But the Eagle-Beacon reported Wednesday that Carr received financial help from her boyfriend, Dr. Florence, who won a malpractice suit against those involved in her son's tonsil and hernia surgery in 1978. The newspaper reported that the bulk of the settlement, \$675,000, was to provide the child an annual contract over the next 37 years. The remainder, \$150,000, went to Florence's lawyers and about \$170,000 to her and her wife. Florence's former wife, Emma Jenkins, told the Eagle-Beacon she thought Florence had provided financial help to Carr.

**Services that convicts leave discontinued**

BLOOMSBURG, Pa. — Officials decided to ban group religious services at Columbia County Prison because inmates have a knack for escaping during Gideon Bible Society meetings. The escape of two inmates Monday, similar to a prison break in December, convinced officials to ban the group sessions," said William Barratt, a prison guard. The latest escapees, Thomas Loran, 17, of Bloomsburg, Pa., and Michael Frey, 30, of Berks Pa., were captured Tuesday in Lewisburg, Pa., 30 miles from jail, Bloomsburg police officer Al Wagner said. An unidentified 40-year-old woman who allegedly helped the pair escape also was arrested. Loran and Frey allegedly climbed two guards and walked out the prison front door Monday night, causing a disturbance at a Gideon meeting.
