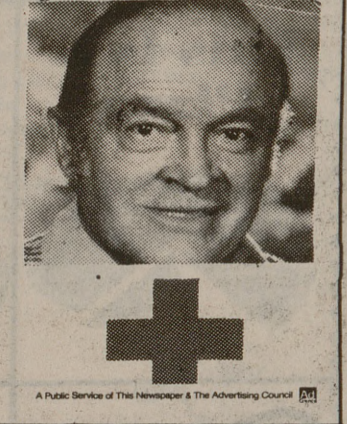

'Grand old man' dies at 91

Dr. George B. Wilcox, "The grand old man of Texas education," died Monday night in Dallas at the age of 91.

Wilcox served for 50 years in public education — 40 of them at Texas A&M University. He was a professor and the head of the Department of Education and Psychology when he retired in 1959.

"His greatest achievement was his leadership in educational administration," said Dr. Paul R. Hensarling, professor emeritus of educational administration. "He was just what the name implies — a grand old man of Texas education."

Wilcox received that title for his service as Grand High Scribe of the Ancient and Beneficent Order of the Red Red Rose, an organization of Texas school administrators.

He is survived by his wife Ruth and daughter Joanna Carr, both of Dallas, his brother Tom Wilcox of Navasota, four grandchildren and a great grandchild.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday in the chapel of Callaway Jones Funeral Home.

Tombstone plays tapes

SUNNYVALE, Calif. — For those who wish to speak to their loved ones in the great hereafter, engineer Stanley Zelazny has come up with a \$10,000, "electronic tombstone" operated with solar energy.

Zelazny, 37, of Sunnyvale, a senior manufacturing engineer at Four Phase Systems, Inc., a major electronics firm in Cupertino, Calif., invented the tombstone which transmits muted recordings of the voice of the deceased.

Zelazny and his partner in invention, Michael O'Piel of Pieta, Kansas, have acquired a patent on the plexiglass enclosure with solar collector placed in a low-out tombstone. The tombstone contains a small speaker and a three-inch square solar panel. "This can play up to 90 minutes of pre-recorded gab from graves, and the solar device operates under all extremes of weather — even buried under snow," Zelazny said.

"Every single rock star would want one — it's an ego trip," Zelazny said. "For security-conscious corpses, there is a button device which activates the machine only to preselected listeners who punch in their security number."

Zelazny said he has already been contacted by one prospective buyer — an unidentified Texan.

The sound level of the voice of the deceased is muted so that mourners standing close to the tombstone can hear it, he said.

"A gravesite is personal property. There will be no charges disturbing the peace," Zelazny said. "We're going to change it's good, and America and world wants it."
