Clarendon hotel fire is a mystery

CLARENDON — About 30 children escaped injury in an explosion and fire at a day care center housed in the historic Allen Hotel because they had been allowed to play outdoors to take advantage of an unseasonably warm, sunny day.

The children were playing across the street from the two-story brick building when a still unexplained explosion caused the

historic structure to burn Monday about 4 p.m.

Three employees of the Donley County Community Action Center still inside the building also escaped injury, as did building owner Steve Rogers, his daughter and two grandchildren.

Clarendon, a town of 2,200, is the county seat of Donley County located about 60 miles east of Amarillo.

The old Main Street hotel housed a day care center in front and automotive repair shop in back. Rogers and his wife occupied the second story.

Cause of the fire is not known, but officials have speculated

either a spray can of paint near a hot water heater exploded or an electrical explosion caused the building to burn.

A police department spokesman said officials had not been able to enter the building to determine what caused the explosion, since the site was still smoldering early today.

Fire departments from five surrounding Panhandle communities were called in to aid the Clarendon Volunteer Fire Department. Firefighters were able to contain the fire to the one building in the downtown block.

A witness said the entire story of the building was engulfed in flames 20 minutes after it began.

Constructed between 1912 and 1925, the hotel had been a nice family-type hotel at the time, said Jeanice Weatherlong, longtime resident of Clarendon and editor of the Clarendon News. It had also been used as a dormitory for Clarendon College, she said.

"When constructed, the hotel had a huge fountain and fish in the center of it," Weatherlong said. "On Saturday afternoon the way to the picture show downtown would stop to watch the fish. They were always welcome."
