his life, but he didn't take the warnings seriously.

McKeel said Saturday he had

received letters warning him to curtail his public appearances or face death.
"Most of them say I should go

on TV and call an end to the TV coverage I've been getting," McKeel said.

'Just a whole lot of them stated they were Vietnam vets and they didn't receive all the parades and publicity when they came home. I don't take them seriously," he

His family was concerned,

Police in McKeel's hometown

of Balch Springs, the Dallas County sheriff's office and the FBI in Dallas all reported they were not aware of death threats against the Marine sergeant freed Jan. 20 after 444 days in captivity in Iran.
When McKeel was briefly

housed at West Point after arriving back in the United States with the other hostages, he drew laughs from reporters who asked about his priorities.

"I know the Marines just want to get back to chasing some women and drinking beer," he
