Widow, mother assumes husband's role as sheriff

GROVETON — The latest woman to become a sheriff in Texas is a 55-year-old mother of five who sees herself as an administrator, avoids patrolling but still carries a pistol in her purse.

Peggy Evans was appointed by the Trinity County Commissioners Court on Feb. 12 to finish the unexpired term of her husband, Lynn, who died of cancer Feb. 6. A tornado wrecked the family property Feb. 10.

"That was some week," she said. "It changed my life quite a bit."
"I've got five deputies who can take care of the patrol. I stay real busy right here in the office. A sheriff's job is much different now than when Lynn took office."

"He was everyone's father confessor as well as chief law enforcement official in the county," she said. "Now it's a paper game. I spend my time just making administrative decisions and trying to stay ahead of government regulations."

Evans said she accepted the job because it was her husband's dying wish to avoid departmental turmoil from rival deputies battling for the job. Four of them applied for the job.

"I called them in separately and asked them how

they felt about working for me," she said. "They said they wanted to keep their jobs. All I ask is that they do their job and remain loyal to me."

Residents appear willing to give Evans a chance. Trinity antique store owner Catherine Ramey said, "She'll have to be pretty good to do the job he did. He was one of the best sheriffs we ever had. But I'm sure she's familiar with the job and its problems."

Lynn Evans term expires in 1982 and, if his wife wants to keep the job, she will have to be elected.

"I'm just going to wait and see how it works out before I decide whether I'll run," she said.

"It's going to be a challenge."
Officials said at least two other Texas women have served as sheriff in recent years.

Glady's Dodds completed the unexpired term of Lavaca County Sheriff Ronny Dodds when he was shot in 1969. Rose Flournoy completed the unexpired term of her husband, Wharton County Sheriff Mike Flournoy, when he died in 1979.

Lynn Evans was Trinity County sheriff from 1959 to 1965, when he left to take a construction job. Supporters urging, Evans ran for sheriff again in 1972. He died one month after being sworn in to another term.

highly successful program in Fitchburg, Mass., which drew participation from more than half of the 38,000 residents with households averaging a 14 percent energy savings.

Excited cow wrecks art studio, class

MINNEAPOLIS — The one thing worse than a bull in a shop is a Black Angus cow in an art studio.

Guy Baldwin, an art instructor at the University of Minnesota, brought a large Black Angus school Monday to be a model in his sculpture class.

As the cow was led into the building, its hoofs became tangled in a rope. The panicked animal broke free, jumped a large table and ran through Wayne Potratz's art class.

He told his students to leave and they wasted no time following orders.

The cow ran down a long hallway and into Baldwin's studio where it destroyed or damaged 10 sculptures he was preparing for a March 9 exhibition. Sculptures were valued at \$5,000, Baldwin said.

The cow left several hoofprints and eluded pursuit for nearly 45 minutes. Finally, three cowhands from the university's beef cattle barn in St. Paul captured the animal, calmed and led it into a trailer outside the ravaged arts building.

"It was funny on the one hand," Potratz said, "but not much fun for the cow or Mr. Baldwin."
