Inflation slows; still cuts deep

WASHINGTON — Inflation fell below double-digit rates in January for the first time since last summer, helped by the first drop in grocery store food prices in nearly a year, the Labor Department reported Wednesday.

The rise in the Consumer Price Index for January was 0.7 percent. That works out to a 9.1 percent inflation rate on a compound annual basis — the amount prices would rise if the monthly rate continued a full year.

The January figure compares with a 13.4

The January figure compares with a 13.4 percent annual inflation rate in December. The last time inflation ran below two digits was last August, when the rate was 9.6 percent.

However, even the reduced January rate made big inroads in the purchasing power of working America.

The consumer price index stood at 260.5 in January, which means that goods costing \$100 in 1967 now cost \$260.50. To put it another way, one 1967 dollar has shrunk in buying value to 38 cents.

Slowing food and housing costs accounted for nearly all the overall improvement in

Food and beverages together registered a zero increase. Prices of food bought at grocery stores actually fell 0.4 percent in January, the first monthly drop since a 0.5 percent decline in February 1980.

Prices of meats, poultry, fish, eggs and fresh fruits and vegetables all contributed to that

Despite the apparent drop in the inflation rate, Murray Weidenbaum, chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers, was not opti-

"The slight decline in food prices was counterbalanced by a sharp rise in energy," he said. "With January's reading, 11.7 percent above a year ago, we are still in a double-digit inflation-

Jalapeno jellies sent to Reagan by Texan


