## Bank dealings of Hunts under exam by S.E.C.

WASHINGTON — The Securities and Exchange Commission has expanded a year-long investigation of the Hunt family of Texas and is now examining their dealings with some of the nation's top banks, it was reported today.  
The Washington Post said documents made public this week indicate the investigation has led far from its original topic — the Hunts' speculation in the silver market and purchase of a large part of the Bache Group Inc., a Wall Street brokerage house.  
The SEC, it said, now wants details of other transactions, including a \$1.1 billion loan to the Hunts' Placid Oil Co. arranged last spring from a group of banks. The loan, arranged with the aid of Federal Reserve Board Chairman Paul Volcker, was intended to help pay Hunt debts after silver prices collapsed.  
What the SEC is looking for is

still secret, said the Post. The agency's mandate is to protect investors in publicly owned companies. All banks involved in the investigation are public companies, as is Bache. The Post said SEC officials insist the latest subpoenas are directly related to the original investigation.  
The SEC, it said, has subpoenaed records of all Hunt dealings with the family's chief banker, First National Bank in Dallas, and late last month told the First National Bank of Chicago and Republic National Bank of Dallas it wants some of their records, too.  
Other banks and brokerage houses have been served with subpoenas in the investigation, it said, including Merrill Lynch Pierce Fenner & Smith, where Treasury Secretary Donald Regan was chairman during the period covered by the SEC subpoenas.  
A Merrill Lynch spokesman said Wednesday the firm is cooperating with the investigation and is not believed to be a target of the securities probe. A Bache official said the firm also is giving the SEC documents and does not consider itself a target.  
The Post said that while documents relating to the Hunt transactions have been turned over to the SEC since its investigation began in April, the Hunts are trying to cut off the flow of information they call "confidential business information" from the eyes of federal investigators.  
Six members of the Hunt family filed suit against the SEC in Dallas Monday, asking that the SEC stop getting records of the Hunts' dealings with the First National Bank in Dallas. They said they sued to "avoid losing rights protected by federal law" and contended SEC lawyers had "improperly expanded the scope of their inquiry."
