James, who alledgedly heard Jimmy Chagra brag of a role in Wood's slaying, was once housed in the same wing as Chagra at Leavenworth federal penitentiary in Kansas. Federal authorities confirmed Saturday they were protecting" James under the federal witness protection program.

A San Antonio newspaper reported Sunday that a group of men held a secret meeting shortly before Wood's assassination at which

The newspaper also reported the same group voted to have Assistant U.S. Attorney James Kerr killed. An attempt was made on Kerr's life, but he escaped.

The newspaper said federal officials have frequently described those responsible for Wood's assassination as part of a criminal organization involved in drug traf-
