RHA asked to support protest of fee increases

Battalion Staff
Vice President for External Affairs David Collins again asked the support of the Residence Halls Association in protesting the proposed increases in tuition fees at the RHA's regular meeting Thursday night. Collins, who said he has attended several hearings

on the issue in Austin, said the 100 percent increase would affect all students, whether they were instate, out-of-state, or foreign students. But medical students would experience a 800 percent increase from \$400 to \$3,600 per scholastic semester.

We need to make an impression on these folks, Collins said, "we really need to get about a thousand

The Lubbock City Council,
