Largest gift
\$25 million
given SMU

DALLAS — A self-made
lionaire and his wife announced
Thursday they were giving \$25
million to Southern Methodist
University, the largest single gift
in the school's history.

Robert Dedman, an attorney
and founder of Club Corporation
of America, and his wife Nancy
said they were giving the money
for endowment of the College
the academic unit recently created
by combining what had been the
School of Humanities and Social
Sciences and the University College.

The College is now the central
educational unit through which
every undergraduate passes.

When asked why the gift was
being given now, Dedman said he
couldn't take it with you, and
think it's fun to give our resources
away now to see some of the fruits
of our lifetime efforts while we
still alive to enjoy them.

The gift is one of the largest
personal gifts in the history of
American higher education, said
SMU President L. Donnell
Shields and SMU trustee Chairman
Edwin L. Cox.

The board of governors voted
Thursday to urge the school's
board of trustees to rename the
college Dedman College. The
board will act on the recommendation
at its May 8 meeting.

"It begins," Dedman said,
"with the strong belief that
those to whom much is given
much is expected. Those who are
blessed and appreciate are doubly
blessed." This is the biblical
junction that leads one to philanthropy.

Dedman said he obviously had
great respect for education, having
earned four degrees himself.

"This enabled me to accumulate
the resources that I have, and that
I also see where to give them so
that others may benefit as I have,"
Dedman said.

Dedman said his entire family
attended SMU and "we believe
that the university is the finest
asset Dallas has and that it de-
serves our generous support."

Born to poor parents in Rison,
Ark., 60 miles south of Little
Rock, Dedman began his career
by earning degrees in business
engineering and law from the Uni-
versity of Texas between 1944 and
1948. During that time he also
served as a commissioned officer
in the U.S. Navy and worked in
real estate and insurance.

In 1953, he completed a master's
law degree at the SMU school of
law.

He was a senior partner with
pair of Dallas law firms from 1948
through 1964. On a "moonlighting
project" in 1957, he launched the
company known as Club
Corporation of America. Started
with Brookhaven Country Club in
Dallas, the firm expanded con-
tinuously and now owns and op-
erates 98 city and country clubs and
seven real estate development
employing 7,000 people.

The Dedmans gave \$1 million
toward the Dedman Center for
Lifetime Sports, which opened at
the SMU campus in 1976.
