Free calendars not error-free in scheduling

What students and faculty must remember about student calendars is that they're a free service. Several mistakes were made in this semester's calendar. The wrong dates for the finals schedules and the last day to Q-drop were printed in this spring's calendar.

"We're just human here in this office," said Cary Wilkins, graduate assistant in the Student Activities Office.

"It's rarely the printer's fault. We always have the opportunity to catch it." Wilkins said after they submit the calendar to the printer, a proof is returned to them to proofread, but "sometimes they (the errors) just slip by us."

The calendar is provided as a service to the students, and is in fact funded out of student service fees and administrative funding.

The semester calendar's purpose is to announce major University events. Space isn't available

for other activities, that's what the monthly calendar is for.

The office ordered 27,500 calendars, costing \$3,200, for this spring. This fall 32,000 calendars, costing \$4,000, have been ordered.

Calendars are distributed to dorms by the area coordinators on campus. The student government gets 9,000 for new student kits, the rest are given to the colleges by departments.

About 8,000 monthly calendars are ordered for each month, at a total cost of \$400.

To schedule something in the calendar, a representative from an organization must come by the Student Activities Office, 222 Memorial Student Center, and fill out a white activities card naming the event, time and date.

The office then files the cards, compiles the calendar and sends it to the printer.

Deadline for fall calendars is July 1. After that, the office has to find an appropriate design for the cover.

"We put a lot of time into it to make it a nice-looking thing, as well as a publication," Wilkins said.

Bullock says no to revised state funds

AUSTIN — Uncertainty concerning the impact on Texas of President Reagan's proposed economic policies has provoked Comptroller Bob Bullock to delay any revisions in his estimate of state revenue available to be spent until the next two years.

Bullock said Thursday he may not revise the revenue estimate until after the Legislature adjourns June 1, a decision that could force legislative budget writers to trim back some of their spending plans for fiscal 1982-83.

"I would like to have the revised forecast done by the time the House and Senate iron out their differences in the budget, but I make no promises," Bullock said.

"But I can promise Texans one thing — the state will not go into the red."

The Legislature can spend only the amount of revenue the comptroller certifies is available for the next two years. If the spending bills exceed the revenue estimate, then the pay-as-you-go provision in the Texas Constitution requires lawmakers to pass sufficient new taxes to support their spending plan.

Although legislative leadership hoped Bullock would raise his revenue estimate by about \$200 million before the Legislature ends, Speaker Bill Clayton said Thursday he is not surprised at the comptroller's delay.

Lt. Gov. Bill Hobby, who earlier in the session has predicted the Senate Finance Committee that Bullock would certify an additional \$192 million in additional revenue, said Thursday he had not seen Bullock's news release announcing the delay in the revenue estimate and therefore would not comment on it.

Bullock said uncertainty about Reagan's economic proposals and the changing nature of the Texas economy are the primary reasons the revenue estimate might have to be delayed until after the Legislature has adjourned. He said sales tax figures critical to auditing tax income are just now coming into his office.
