

Hinckley no stalker of Reagan

WASHINGTON — Federal investigators have found no evidence that John W. Hinckley Jr. charged with attempting to assassinate President Reagan, previously stalked Reagan or any other public official, it was reported Wednesday.

The Washington Post quotes sources as saying the official inquiry into the March 30 shooting, has found Hinckley to be a confused drifter who, apparently earning money from his wealthy parents, wandered aimlessly along the coast.

Sources said the investigation found that Hinckley was in Washington four times before the assassination attempt, but there was no evidence the visits were linked to the attack.

The Post said the findings were included in a 1,200-page summary of the first month of the investigation, prepared by the FBI Washington field office in conjunction with the Secret Service and District of Columbia police. FBI spokesman Roger Young said he could not characterize the evidence in the case, talk about the investigation or even confirm an instance of such a report.

The newspaper said a report of the investigation has been sent to local federal prosecutors.

Sources reiterated that a plan for some of Hinckley's travels was his apparent intention with actress Jodie Foster, a student at Yale University.

Investigators believe Hinckley sought to make an impression on the young movie actress, a motive indicated in a letter addressed to Foster that was found in Hinckley's hotel room after his arrest, the newspaper said.

Hinckley, 25, of Evergreen, Colo., has been charged with trying to kill Reagan and assaulting a Secret Service agent in the attack outside a Washington hotel that also wounded two others.

Sources told the Post Hinckley's actions bore little resemblance to those of Arthur Bremer, the drifter who stalked Richard Nixon and former Alabama Gov. George Wallace before shooting and wounding Wallace in a Maryland shopping center during the 1972 presidential campaign.

Windfall tax hearing set May 18

CHEYENNE, Wyo. — District Judge Ewing T. Kerr delayed a hearing on a motion by the State of Texas to join in a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of the windfall oil profits tax.

The hearing had been set for May 18, but U.S. attorneys asked for additional time, so Kerr recessed this week for June 29.

The motion, signed by Texas Attorney General Mark White, argued the tax is unconstitutional because much of the oil flowing from Alaska is exempt, which he said is a violation of provisions requiring uniform taxation.

Texas said the tax also caused a drop in state oil revenues and a negative effect on efforts to encourage production from strip per wells — those producing less than 10 barrels of crude a day.

The suit was filed
