Charges dropped in weapons case

HOUSTON — Federal prosecutors have dismissed charges against three of the six Europeans arrested at Houston Intercontinental Airport last week in what authorities described as the largest illegal seizure in U.S. history.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Michael Brown said charges were dropped Monday night against three crew members of the chartered Austrian jetliner raided at the airport Tuesday while 2,200 weapons were loaded from a truck.

Freed from charges of violating U.S. neutrality law by trying to combat weapons to South Africa were co-pilot Manfred Stroh, engineer Peter Lenitz, 23, and flight technician Heinz Pollanz, 50, of Vienna.

Still in custody under \$1.5 million bond each were accused smugglers John Parks, 43, and Peter Thomas Towers, 50, of London. Austrian pilot George Bellamy, 57, remained in custody on \$500,000 bond.

Brown said examination of available evidence indicated prosecutors probably could not prove the three freed men knew what they were doing at the time they were arrested.

The plot began with an informant telling federal agents the plane wanted to buy guns for shipment to South Africa — where the U.S. banned weapons export — under a false State Department authorization.

Federal investigators then sent an undercover agent to deal with suspects. The agent bought \$1.2 million worth of weapons from Industries Inc. in Connecticut, trucked the weapons to the airport, then arrested the men when they paid.

TIA 'raises ante' in merger attempt

WASHINGTON — Aggressive Texas International Airlines today raised the ante in its battle to take over much larger Continental Airlines by offering \$14 a share for

Continental stock, \$1 more than its previous offer.

The new offer was delayed Tuesday to Continental's board of directors in Los Angeles. President Frank Lorenzo said meeting with reporters in Washington. Like the previous offer, the new one expires Thursday.

Lorenzo said the new offer is almost 50 percent above the price at which Continental had prior to the May 6 Continental shareholders meeting. TIA owns 45.5 percent of Continental's stock.

Continental is fighting takeover effort with plans to issue 15.4 million new shares of stock to be purchased by its employees which would dilute TIA's ownership.

Agents in Los Angeles, claiming the stock price would be inflated by the current share price, are also fighting the offer.

Lorenzo also said a cross-industry boycott put into effect earlier this month by the Air Line Pilots Association "has hurt Texas International's traffic very significantly."

The pilot group announced a boycott late last month against TIA, its parent company, Texas Corp., and New York Air, owned by Texas Air.

Lorenzo estimated overall traffic is down "2, 4 or 5 percent" that interline traffic combined with Continental flights is down by one-third.

He said there has been no impact on New York Air, partly because that carrier's business is self-contained and does not depend on interline traffic.

New York Air flies from New York to LaGuardia airport to Washington and Boston.

ITIA wins the Los Angeles and stops the Continental employee stock ownership plan still must win Civil Aeronautics Board approval for the takeover.

TIA is trying to win CAB consideration of the merger. Currently, a decision is expected in August. Lorenzo was in Washington today to appear before a federal administrative law judge to argue for a swifter decision.
