United Press International HOUSTON — Federal prosecutors have dismissed charges; three of the six Europeans arrested at Houston Intercont port last week in what authorities described as the largest lleg seizure in U.S. history.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Michael Brown said charges were Monday night against three crew members of the chartered Au jetliner raided at the airport Tuesday while 2,200 weapons were loaded from a truck. Freed from charges of violating U.S. neutrality law by trying

combat weapons to South Africa were co-pilot Manford Strengineer Peter Lenitz, 23, and flight technician Heinz Pollan Still in custody under \$1.5 million bond each were accused? ers John Parks, 43, and Peter Thomas Towers, 50, of London B

Austrian pilot George Bellamy, 57, remained in custody \$500,000 bond. Brown said examination of available evidence indicated pros probably could not prove the three freed men knew what they doing at the time they were arrested.

The plot began with an informant telling federal agents these wanted to buy guns for shipment to South Africa — where the U.S. banned weapons export — under a false State Department auth

Federal investigators then sent an undercover agent to deal with suspects. The agent bought \$1.2 million worth of weapons for Industries Inc. in Connecticut, trucked the weapons to the air then arrested the men when they paid.


