Truck drivers request high weight limits on highways

LITTLE ROCK — Highway Commissioner James Branyan says he is convinced Arkansas businesses need an 80,000-pound truck weight limit if they are to survive, but someone will have to pay for the roads they use.

Although no formal vote was taken, the Truck Weight Study Commission adjourned Tuesday in apparent agreement that Arkansas' truck weight limit will have to be raised. The members had just heard five hours of testimony from representatives of agri-culture, industry, shipping and transportation, who all said Arkansas' higher transportation costs place them at a disadvantage in the marketplace.
