Impressive drilling record set

Oil firm on streak

SAN ANTONIO — A vice president of Sage Energy Co. attributes the firm's remarkable drilling record to luck and experienced people.
The company has drilled at least 45 consecutive oil and gas wells without hitting a dry hole since June 1980, said Jim Hollrah, vice president for financial and legal affairs.
He said they hit one dry hole out of 43 wells attempted in the previous fiscal year.
"I certainly won't be cocky enough to suggest this type of thing could go on indefinitely," Hollrah said. "But it's been a very good year."
The company's earnings have quadrupled since 1977. In 1978, Sage Energy earned \$2.8 million in after-tax income, and although fiscal 1981 income has not been made official, Hollrah estimates it at about \$12 million.
He said anyone who invested \$1,000 in the company when it went public in 1977 would now have \$70,000 in stock.

"We've always had a good track record," he said. "It's a combination of luck and a lot of experienced people."
Sage Energy was organized by former oil executive-turned-wildcatter K.K. Amin, who formed the company and remains its president and majority stockholder.
Hollrah attributes the company's success to the conservative selection of drilling sites and a great deal of luck.
Hollrah said the company will probably drill in excess of 60 wells, mostly in West Texas in the Chalk and south Texas.
"The price of oil will not affect the economic what we've planned," Hollrah said. "It'll hold down a whole lot before it affects our drilling."
Almost as impressive as its drilling record, Sage has accumulated oil and gas reserves of 10 million barrels and company officials expect the newest reserves will exceed 10 million barrels.

Court rules on divorce suit

AUSTIN (UPI) — An abused spouse can combine a suit for damages for personal injuries with a divorce action against his or her mate, the Texas Supreme Court ruled Wednesday.
The court, without written comment, upheld a lower court decision awarding Dorothy Mogford of Menard County a divorce and property settlement along with \$20,000 for personal injuries resulting from abuse by her former husband, Lorenzo Mogford.
The case is the first time in Texas a personal injury suit filed by one spouse against another has been combined with a divorce action.
A jury in the combined divorce and personal

injury suit awarded her \$20,000 in actual damages but no punitive damages, and granted the divorce and property settlement.
In his appeal, Mogford contended the trial court was wrong in awarding damages for injuries sustained by his wife during their marriage.
The Court of Civil Appeals rejected the appeal, however, saying in its opinion, "The law disability that prohibits one spouse from suing for grievances against the other has been in retreat in this state."
"A woman is no longer viewed as an appendage of her husband. She is an individual with rights of her own and not merely a subordinate of the male."

Abilene nursery closed marijuana use suspected

ABILENE — A day care center is closed pending the outcome of a hearing to determine whether it should be closed permanently because children there were allegedly exposed to marijuana and narcotics paraphernalia.
State Judge Billy John Edwards granted a temporary restraining

order closing Mary's Nursery Tuesday on the complaint of investigators with the state Department of Human Resources.
Taylor County Assistant District Attorney George S. Edwards no criminal charges been filed in connection with alleged marijuana because state agency's main interest closing the facility.
DHR Investigator McWhorter said in an affidavit that in June he and a state investigator found a pipe containing what appeared to be the burned residue of marijuana on a bedroom end table.
Their visit was prompted by reports that marijuana was smoked around the nursery.
The affidavit also said McWhorter found some smoked, hand rolled cigarettes and a small amount of leafy material he believed marijuana in a butter dish in another bedroom.
Eleven children ranging from 18 months to 9 years were in the nursery during the search, McWhorter said.
He said when he showed the pipe and suspected marijuana to nursery operator Betty Harsh she told him "she had never smoked it before and didn't know who belonged to."
McWhorter told newspapermen while he has not conducted chemical tests on his findings, veteran policeman and investigator Harsh said he believed marijuana when he saw the pipe and the public can be assured tests will be conducted promptly.
