# Officials charged in milk fraud

**BROWNSVILLE** — A federal magistrate planned to set bonds Wednesday for 10 of 13 dairy and Mission School District officials who have been charged with defrauding the federal milk subsidy program out of more than \$500,000.

The 13 officials, including the president of Golden Jersey Creamery of Edinburg, Texas, and an assistant superintendent of the Mission School District, were indicted Tuesday in a 13-count federal grand jury indictment. Prosecutors said 10 of the 13 officials were arrested and jailed at the Hidalgo County Jail late Tuesday and the accused officials were to appear Wednesday before U.S. Magistrate William Mallet.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Daniel Ramirez said the officials were charged with submitting \$495,655 in false reimbursement claims for the U.S. Department of Agriculture's milk subsidy program.

The indictments also alleged conspiracy to collect another \$31,982 in false claims. The charges involved the federal program which partially reimburses low income school districts for milk purchases. Another milk program cited in the indictments was the USDA's summer food service program for children of low income families.

Mission school district officials named in the indictments included food services director Michael Jon McCarthy, 33, Pharr, Texas; former food services director Myrtle I. Cad-

dell, 62, McAllen, Texas; assistant school superintendent Robert H. Wicks, 55, Mission; assistant food services director Gerardo M. Cortez, 46, Mission; former food services truck driver Edelmiro Garcia, 38, Mission; former cook Angelica H. Padron, 38, Mission; and, former services secretaries Jane A. Cook, 41, and Daphne Thompson, 32, both of Mission.

Golden Jersey Creamery officials named in the indictments were: dairy president Frederick N. Haggard, Edinburg; office manager Jose T. Martinez, 28, Mission; sales manager Duane L. Towne, 58, Pharr; board member Irma M. Cortez, 39, Edinburg, and comptroller J. Hall, 25, of San Antonio.

Pugh said Tuesday Mobil has threatened to cancel his lease unless he returns to Mobil products at all pumps within seven days. He also said Mobil refuses to deliver the super unleaded his no-name supplier cannot supply.

Pugh said Mobil officials blame the fact that his contracts minimum 9,000-gallon shipments but he now wants only 5,000 deliveries of super unleaded. They are trying to hold him to contract.

Pugh said Mobil charges him 8 cents a gallon more than independent marketers charge no-name dealers for regular and super gasoline. He said he questioned Mobil's higher price and Mobil must cover losses on other investments.

"I couldn't compete with the independent dealers and grow was at the point where I had to make a change or just shut the door let Mobil have the station back."

Pugh covered up the Mobil emblem on his regular and super pumps two weeks ago, bought a low grade of no-name gas and started it cheaper. He said the lower price "makes me even with my competitor in Texas City."

# Senate postpones districting decision

**AUSTIN** — At the beginning of the week predictions were the Senate would quickly approve a congressional redistricting plan the timetable has been changed because a Central Texas senate decided to present his own compromise plan.

The Senate agreed Tuesday to postpone for at least one month any further action on the reapportionment of congressional districts give Sen. John Wilson, D-La Grange, time to complete what compromise he says will satisfy Gov. Bill Clements, two major groups and the courts.

Wilson said his compromise redistricting plan will create a predominantly black district in Dallas demanded by Clements and a Coalition for Minority Representation, and also establish a predominantly Mexican-American district in South Texas.

Sens. Oscar Mauzy, D-Dallas, and Peyton McKnight, D-Dallas, have another proposal that has the backing of the state's 19 Democratic congressmen, but it does not create the black district in Dallas. Clements has said is necessary to avoid a veto.
