# Prisoner weds by proxy honeymoon set for 2001

DALLAS — Randy Lee Davenport decided not to let a life sentence for aggravated robbery, a 10-year sentence for attempted capital murder, two five-year sentences for forgery and drug charges or a last minute ban on jailhouse weddings interfere with his long-planned nuptials.

In the end, Davenport, 27, finally had to have his sister-in-law stand in as his proxy at his wedding ceremony last week.

It was something we always talked about and we figured there was no better time than now to do it," Davenport said of his marriage to Marita Stanley, 20, the mother

of his two children.

Davenport says he agreed to the marriage-by-proxy so his children could have his last name.

"Once we are married, she can send in the marriage certificate to Austin and get his (last child's) birth certificate changed," he said. "That way, when he gets bigger he won't wonder how come he ain't got a daddy on his birth certificate."

Davenport was scheduled to be married two weeks ago, but at the last minute the chaplain refused to accept a handwritten note from a prosecutor approving the marriage. The wedding was postponed for a week, during which time jail authorities banned all inmate weddings.

"It has been getting larger and larger (the number of request for weddings), and it has been a drain on our manpower," said Assistant Chief Deputy Bobby Joe Dale. "It takes people to pull them out of the tank or cell. Then you have to bring up the chaplain and the outside person. It is actually a breach of security."

He said he also was worried about the impact of inmate marriages on criminal cases and spouses cannot testify against another.

"It might be a witness or a suspect," he said. "We're a little uneasy about it because we don't run background checks. We hate to grant a marriage license to a man in Harris County jailhouse."

Davenport and his wife have been planning the wedding for months when the news broke into effect last week. Also, assessed the life sentence for robbery, he said, he agreed to bargain charges of forgery, possession of drugs and attempted murder so prosecutors would allow his wedding.

Last Wednesday, his sister-in-law took the papers to a justice of the peace.

He said not attending the wedding was a bit of a disappointment.

"We didn't expect any money," Davenport said, "but we would have helped if we have seen each other."

He said his honeymoon had been delayed until he is paroled. He figures that will occur in the year 2001.

Reagan's 2 life terms in letters

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — An El Paso man who threatened President Reagan will be sent to a federal prison facility in Springfield, Mo., for competency evaluation.

U.S. District Judge J. Edgar G. G. ordered the man Tuesday during a brief hearing on the defendant Alfred Leroy Baker.

Baker was indicted by grand jury two months ago and charged with mailing a letter to Reagan from Albuquerque. Baker said: "Nothing personal, I'm going to kill you."

Baker will have competency summer.

A federal grand jury Douglas Jackson Dyer Cruces in May on similar charges.

Dyer, 41, is accused of writing the letter to Reagan. He said: "I'm going to Washington and am going to assassinate you on May 5, 1981."
