United Press International AUSTIN — Liberal Democrats who nar-rowly lost attempts during committee deliberations to give a congressional redistricting bill

more Democratic dominance have pledged to continue the fight before the full House. Rep. Craig Washington, D-Houston, said Tuesday he and at least four other members of the House Committee on Regions, Compacts and Districts would present a minority report to the House. The full House was expected to

begin debate on the congressional reappor-tionment plan at 11 a.m. Wednesday.

"I think our plan is truly reflective of the committee and the House," Washington said. Washington and Reps. Hugo Berlanga, D-Corpus Christi, and Paul Ragsdale, D-Dallas, lost narrow attempts to amend the plan by the committee chairman, Rep. Tim Von Dohlen, D-Goliad.

Von Dohlen stalled committee action on his plan for three days last week when it appeared that Ragsdale had the necessary 10 votes for
