Soccer clinic held Aug. 22

Two Brazilian soccer coaches will conduct a coaching clinic Aug. 22 in College Station as part of the seventh annual exchange of the Partners of the Americas program. The program is part of an effort to expose coaches and players in the United States to the coaching expertise of these Brazilian soccer experts.

Jose Barbosa Marques, professor of education from Belem, Brazil, and Narcilvo Cardoso da Silva, professor of physical education from the Federal University of Paranaiba, were chosen on the basis of professional knowledge, academic experience and knowledge of soccer techniques. The College Station clinic, which will be held at the Texas A&M University intramural complex, is only one of a series of clinics which have been coordinated by Texas A&M soccer coach Telmo Franco.

The local clinic will be split into special sessions for youngsters, adults and coaches, and will each last two hours. All sessions will feature specialized instruction involving audio-visual aids, skills

demonstrations and individual practice periods.

Coach Cardoso da Silva, the 37-year-old coach of the soccer team at the Federal University of Paranaiba, has played professional soccer and has coached the sport during the past eight years. He has played volleyball and coached track, as well as having been a professor of physical education and a sports consultant at the university.

Cardosa da Silva participated in the Partners of the Americas program in 1975 and 1977, holding clinics in Connecticut during those years.

The program is being supported by the Converse Rubber Company, Anheuser-Busch and AMF Voit, and is recognized by the U.S. International Communication Agency.

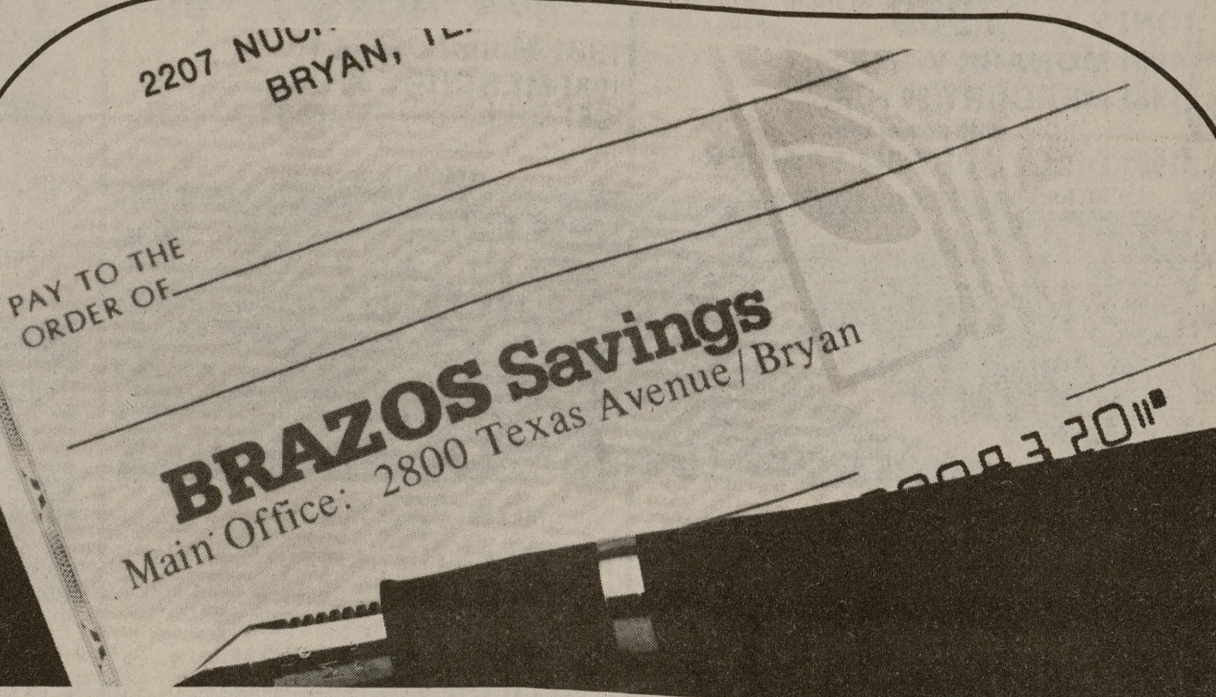
